Special Officer Nominations & Election

Special Officer Nominations and Election shall be conducted as the first order of business (Item #1 on that month's agenda).

The presiding officer shall convene the nominations and elections process as outlined below:

Nominations:

- The presiding officer will convene the process to accept nominations from the floor.
- A list of nominees will be recorded.
- The presiding officer will close the nomination process.
- The presiding officer will convene a vote to accept the list of nominee/s.

Election:

- If there is one (1) nominee for the position, the presiding officer will allow the nominee up to three (3) minutes to address the task force, then convene the voting process via roll-call vote to appoint the nominee to the position.
- If there are multiple nominees for the position, the presiding officer will allow each (in order nominations were made) up to three (3) minutes each to address the task force.
- The presiding officer will then open the floor to members to make a motion to appoint a nominee. Motions are accepted in order as received. If the motion receives a second, the presiding officer will convene the voting process to elect the nominee via roll-call vote. This process will be repeated until a majority vote is reached for one nominee.
