RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN A LETTER OF INTENT TO PARTNER WITH CALTRANS TO INSTALL TRASH REDUCTION INFRASTRUCTURE IN THE STORM DRAIN SYSTEM

WHEREAS, The San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) adopted the Municipal Regional Stormwater Permit (MRP), Order No. R2-2015-0049, on November 18, 2015; and

WHEREAS, The MRP Provision C.10, Trash Load reduction, requires Permittees to reduce trash loads from municipal separate storm sewer systems by 40% by 2014, 70% by 2017, 80% by July 1, 2019, and 100% by 2022; and

WHEREAS, Caltrans, in an effort to comply with MRP Provision C.10, intends to partner with the City of Hayward (City) to treat stormwater from portions of the 880 freeway located in Hayward; and

WHEREAS, The City has identified three potential locations for hydrodynamic separator (HDS) units that would treat 1,255 acres, including 1,128 acres of City responsibility and 127 acres of Caltrans' right of way.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward that the City Manager is hereby authorized to submit a Letter of Intent to Caltrans and to negotiate terms of a cooperative agreement Caltrans for the installation of trash reduction infrastructure in Hayward's storm drain system.
