

Officer Nomination & Election

The presiding officer shall convene the nominations and elections process as outlined below:

Nominations:

- The presiding officer will convene the process to accept nominations from the floor.
- The presiding officer will close the nomination process and announce the list of nominees for each seat.

Elections:

- If there is one (1) nominee for the position, the presiding officer will allow the nominee up to three (3) minutes to address the commission, then convene the voting process via a motion/second followed by roll-call vote to appoint the nominee to the position (chair/vice chair.)
- If there are multiple nominees for the position, the presiding officer will allow each nominee (in order nominations were made) up to three (3) minutes each to address the commission, then convene the voting process to elect one nominee via a motion/second followed by roll-call vote.

This process will be followed for each position one (1) Chair and one (1) Vice Chair. If there is one nominee for each seat, the voting process can be combined.

If no commissioner volunteers to serve as Chair/Vice Chair, the position shall default to the most senior commissioner who has not recently served as Chair/Vice Chair.
