RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE \$100,000 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM PACIFIC GAS & ELECTRIC FOR THE NO-COST RESIDENTIAL CHIPPING PROGRAM AND DEFENSIBLE SPACE RESIDENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The City of Hayward’s Fire Department provides an annual Chipping Program to help residents create defensible space on their properties and a Resident Assistance Program to assist disabled or low-income residents with tree trimming and clearing; and

WHEREAS, Pacific Gas & Electric (PG&E) has awarded the City a \$100,000 grant to supplement the chipping program and provide additional resident assistance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Hayward authorizes the City Manager to accept and appropriate \$100,000 to Fund 240 in grant funding from PG&E for the Defensible Space Resident Assistance Program.
