RESOLUTION APPROVING FUNDING RECOMMENDATIONS AND APPROPRIATING THE SPECIAL REVENUE FUNDS FOR MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 1-2021 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Hayward hereby approves and adopts the Maintenance District No. 1-2021 funding recommendations for Fiscal Year 2022, as shown in the attached Exhibit A, in a total revenue amount of \$464,179 and a total expenditure amount not to exceed \$414,176 which is incorporated by reference herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Hayward hereby approves and adopts the Maintenance District No. 1-2021 funding recommendations for Fiscal Year 2022, as shown in the attached Exhibit A, in a total revenue amount of \$464,179, and that \$379,000 of the total revenue amount may be deposited into fund 270 by way of a fund transfer between the Storm Water Operating Fund (615) and the Maintenance District 1-2021 Fund (270).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that except as may be otherwise provided, any and all expenditures relating to the objectives described in the Maintenance District No. 2 budget are hereby approved and authorized and payments therefore may be made by the Director of Finance of the City of Hayward without further action of Council.
