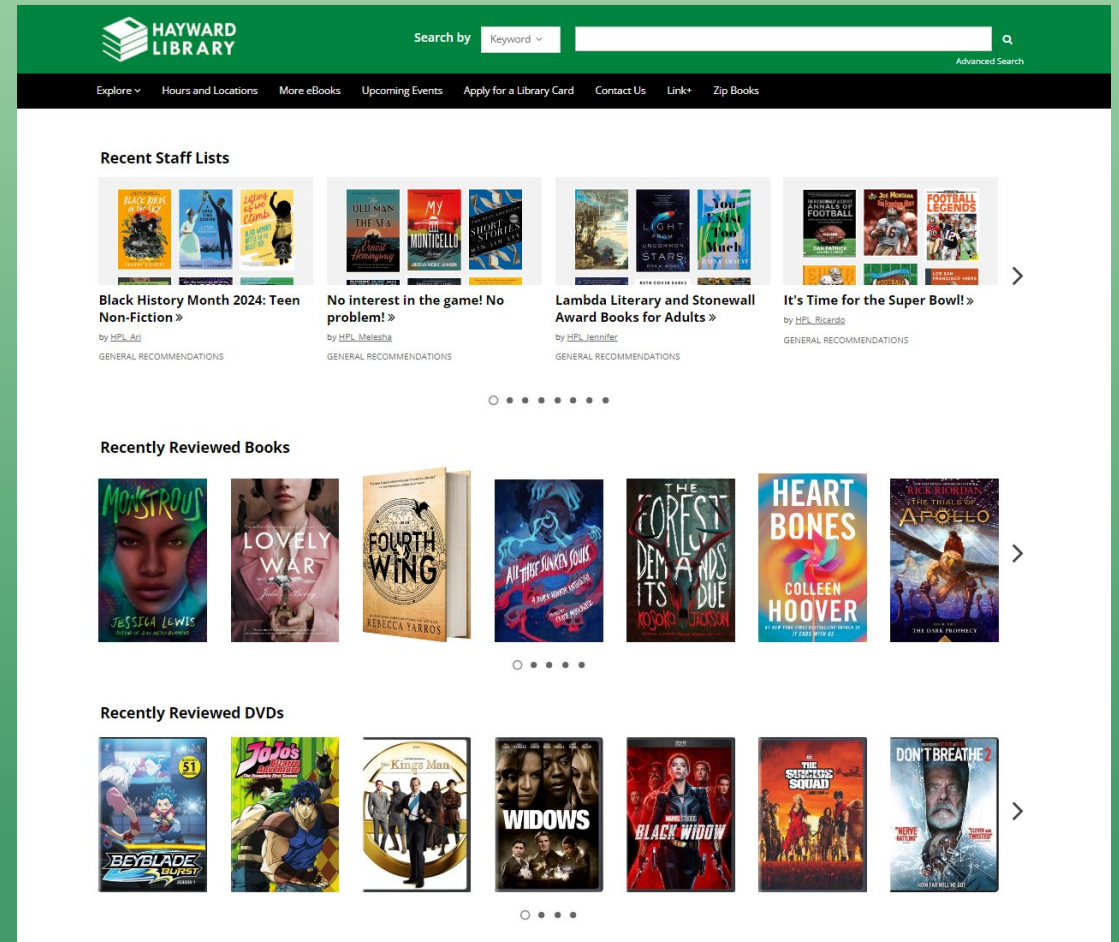

- Includes links to relevant databases and online resources.

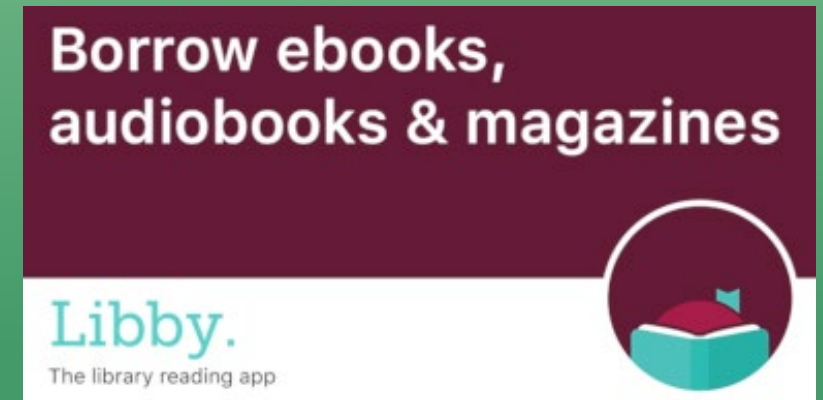
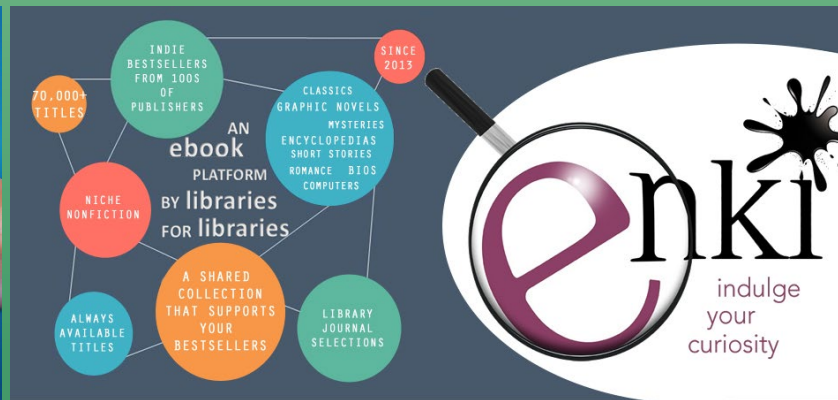




# Download and Stream – eBooks and Audiobooks

Over 1,000,000 ebooks and downloadable audiobooks in multiple languages for all ages.

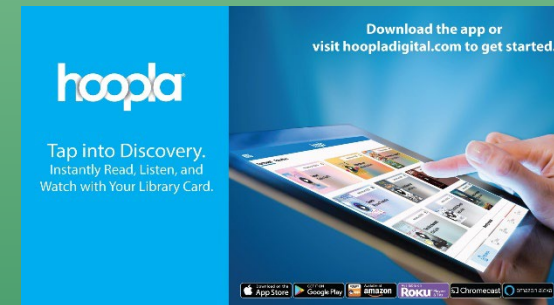
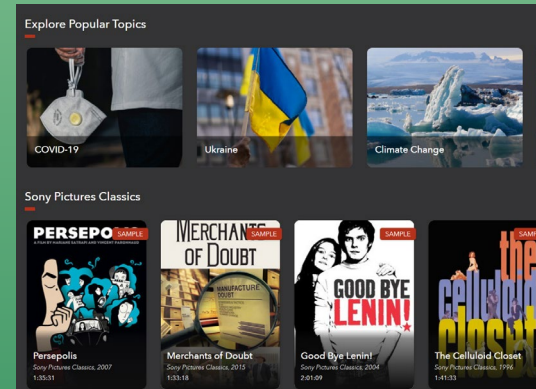
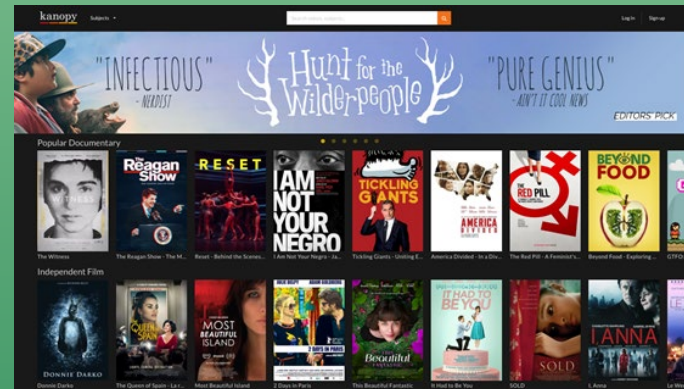
- Overdrive (Libby App) Ebooks, audiobooks, comics/graphic novels and magazines

Over 100,000 streaming albums, TV shows, and movies.

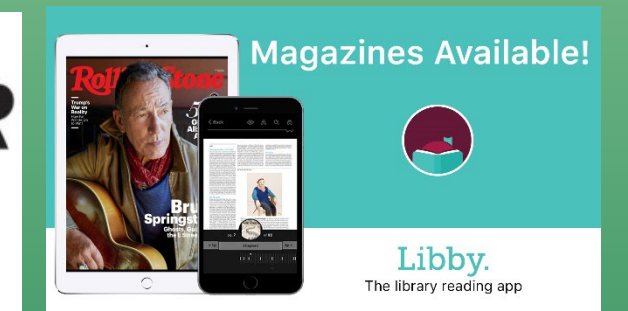

## EQUITY

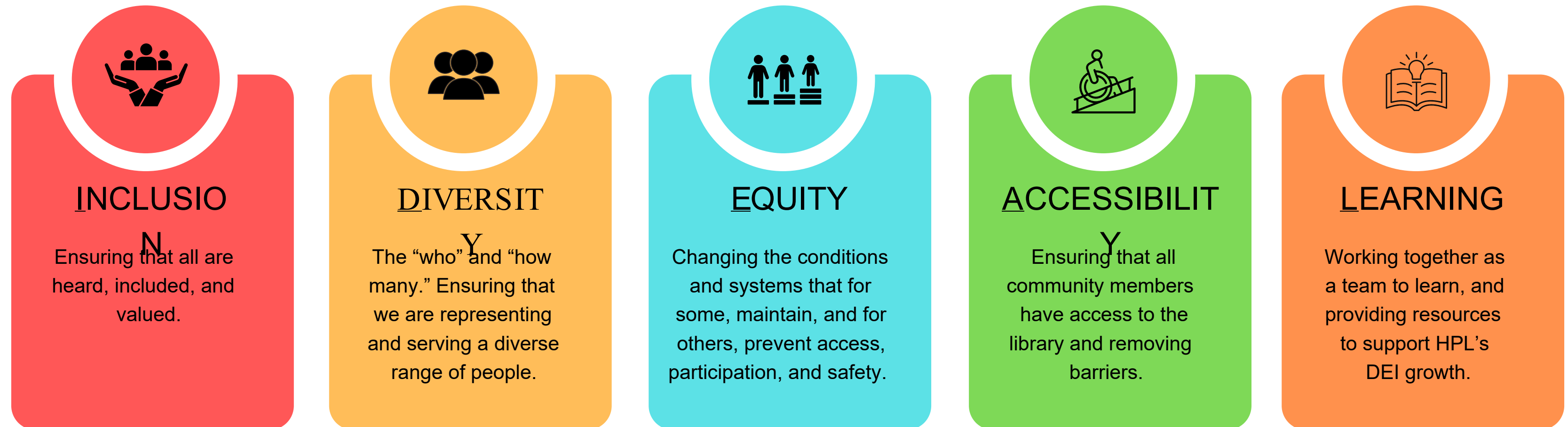
Changing the conditions and systems that for some, maintain, and for others, prevent access, participation, and safety.

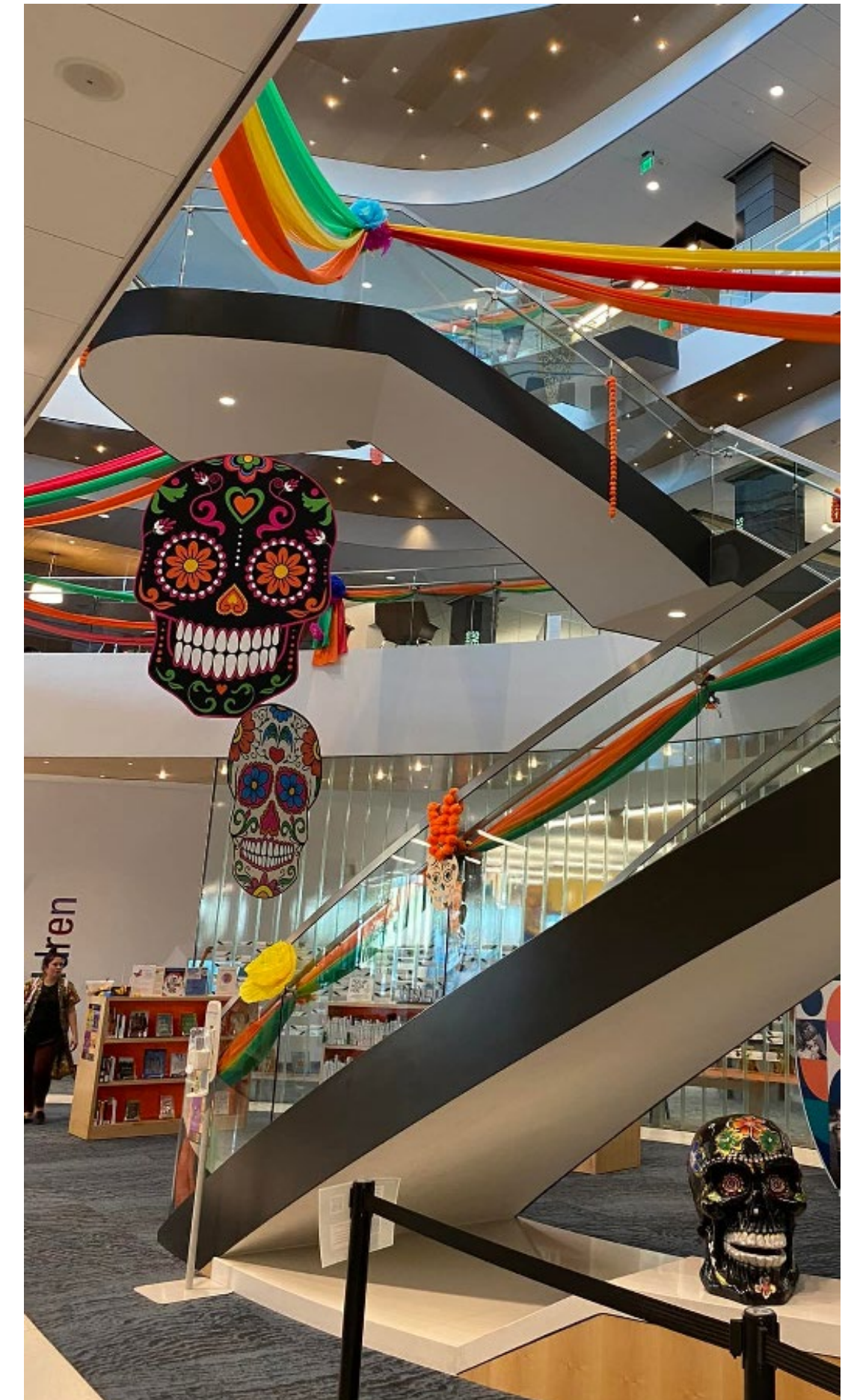



- We visit community partner agencies, schools, after-school programs, parks, senior centers, mobile home communities, and neighborhoods.

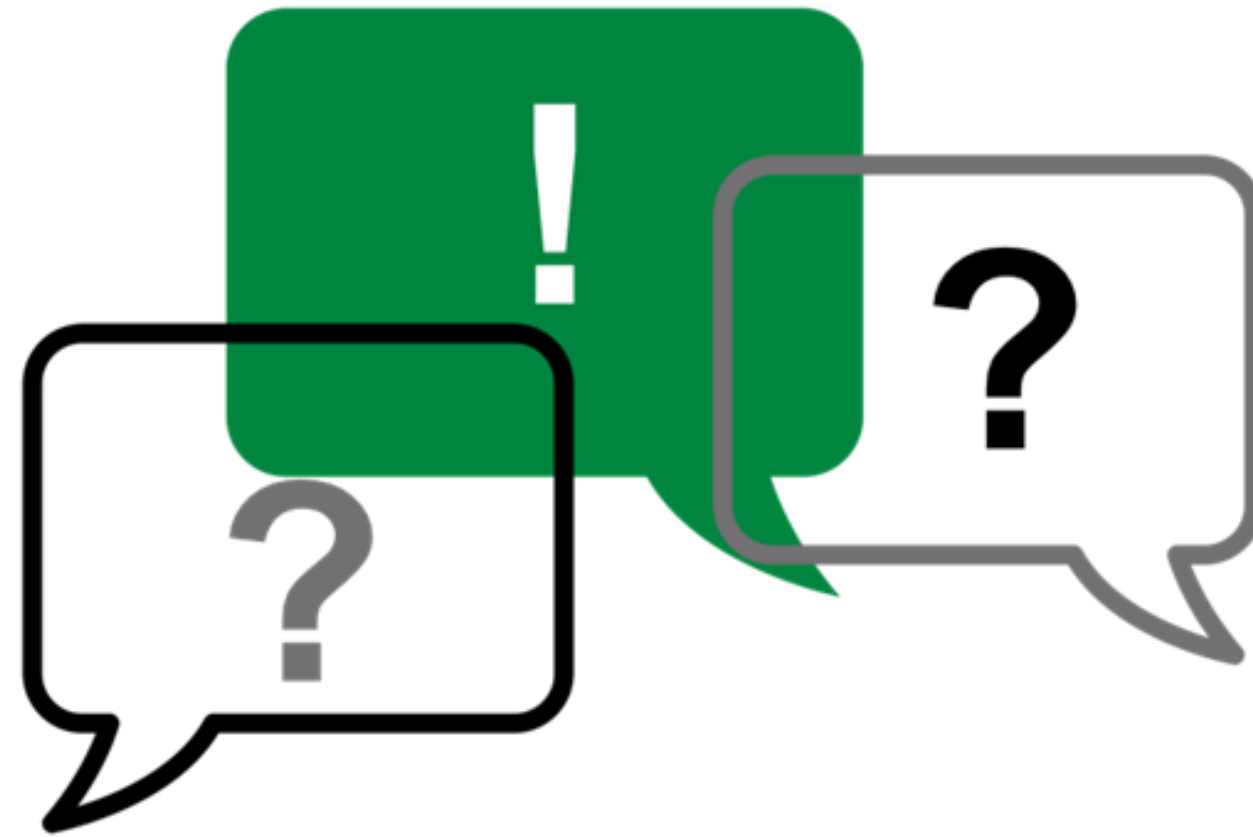


# Bridging the Digital Divide



- **Tech Lending Library:** Hayward residents age eighteen or over (18+) can check-out a variety of devices
- **Tech Support Sessions:** Community members can meet 1-on-1 with a tutor for computer, tablet, or phone help.
