RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO APPROVE THE
RECOMMENDED ALIGNMENT FOR THE EAST BAY GREENWAY
MULTIMODAL PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Alameda County Transportation Commission (Alameda CTC) is the project sponsor and implementing agency for the East Bay Greenway Multimodal (EBGWMM) Urban Trail Project (Urban Trail) from the Lake Merritt Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) station in Oakland to South Hayward BART station in Hayward; and

WHEREAS, Alameda CTC and City Staff determined challenges regarding an alignment connecting the Hayward BART station to the South Hayward BART station through Mission Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, Alameda CTC and City staff recommend the alignment on the following streets:

- A Street – Mission Boulevard to Grand Street
- Grand Street - A Street to Meek Avenue
- Meek Avenue - Grand Street to Silva Avenue at Jackson Street
- Silva Avenue – Jackson Street to Sycamore Avenue
- Sycamore Avenue – Silva Avenue to Whitman Street
- Whitman Street – Sycamore Avenue to Tennyson Road
- Tennyson Road – Whitman Street to Dixon Street; and

WHEREAS, the streets on this alignment are consistent with Hayward's current Bicycle and Pedestrian Plan (2020).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council hereby approves the recommended alignment for the East Bay Greenway Multimodal Project.
