RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING \$664,000 FOR THE PURCHASE OF TRASH CAPTURE DEVICES FOR CABOT BLVD.; PROJECT NO. 07746, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AMEND AN AGREEMENT WITH CALTRANS TO RECEIVE AN ADDITIONAL \$800,000 IN FUNDING, AND FINDING THE PROJECT TO BE CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM CEQA REVIEW

WHEREAS, the City is required by the San Francisco Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) to reduce all trash from stormwater systems to waters of the state by 100% by July 1, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City and Caltrans worked collaboratively to find a location for trash capture devices on Cabot Boulevard that will count toward both agencies' compliance targets; and

WHEREAS, the City and Caltrans entered into a Cooperative Implementation Agreement in 2021 and amended the agreement in 2023 whereby Caltrans agreed to fully fund trash capture projects, including Tennyson Road and Arf Avenue, in Hayward; and

WHEREAS, Caltrans has agreed to provide up to \$800,000 in additional funding to complete the Cabot Boulevard project, a third location for trash reduction beyond the original agreement scope; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, on March 25, 2025, adopted Resolution 25-037 approving the sole-source purchase of three Continuous Deflective Separator (CDS) trash capture devices from Contech, the only manufacturer of a CDS unit approved by the San Francisco Regional Water Quality Control Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Hayward that \$664,000 is hereby appropriated to project No. 07746.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council hereby authorized the City Manager to amend the cooperative implementation agreement with Caltrans to receive an additional \$800,000 in funding.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council finds this project to be categorically exempt from environmental review in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15301, Class 1 (Minor Alteration of Existing Facilities) and Section 15302, Class 2 (Replacement or Reconstruction of Existing Facilities) of the CEQA Guidelines.
