

CHAPTER 6

ARTICLE 13

TRANSPORTATION PERMITS

Regulation Proposal as recommended and reviewed by the Police, City Attorney and Public Works Department's

- \* Requires Minimum Insurance Liability Depending on the Load Type
- \*Responsible for Property Damage in transit
- \*Permit doesn't relieve them of liability due to roadway limitations (low overpass/ power line / trees)
- \*Special Restrictions may be placed on the load such as police escorts, pilot cars and curfew
- \*Ordinance will give the City of Hayward the Authority to accept, deny or modify a desired route



#### Permit Process

- \*Nearly all are handled through a Permit Processing Company who then submits permits to every entity on the route using the CALTRANS Permit Format.
- \*HPD will review each permit and accept/deny or modify it.
- \*Each Permit Company will receive a monthly bill of all permits submitted.

### Business Impact


- \*Financial Impact is minimal due to fee being \$16-90.
- \*Business will ship/receive their product but their route and loading is regulated by our City.
- \*The only impacted parties are the Permit Processing Companies who will be required to add our city to their Regulated Routes

#### Residential Impact

\*Public Works and the Police Department have generated a Truck Route Map that is available online

\* Routes are main arterial roadways which are predominantly industrial or lightly residential

### Roadway / Route Review

\*Public Works will monitor the published truck route roadways for wear and damage

\*Funding from the permits is allowed to be used for roadway repairs per the Calif. Vehicle Code

## FY 2017 GF Adjustments (Revenues)



FY 2017 revenues were are projected to be \$6.8M (4.7%) over the adopted budget (\$3.7M considered 1-time revenue), 2% change in ongoing revenues.

- Changes to plan reflected are based on actuals thus far in FY 2017
  - ▶ UUT Prior Periods Payment of plus \$3M
  - Property Tax plus \$1.7M, assessed valuation up, prop 8 restoration nearly complete
  - Sales Tax plus \$801K, Real Property Transfer Tax plus \$646K, Charges for Services plus \$650K

## FY 2017 GF Adjustments (Expenditures)



FY 2017 expenditures are projected to be \$5M (3.3%) over the adopted budget, of this \$3M is a 1-time expenditure (UUT set-aside).

- Staffing Expenses
  - ▶ Increases: Overtime plus \$1.5M
  - ▶ Decreases: Significant Vacancy Savings \$3M, Medical and related benefits \$1.6, PERS \$854K
- Operating Expenses
  - Encumbrance and Budget Carryforwards plus \$1.4M
  - Grant Carryforwards and new Appropriations plus \$224K

## FY 2017 GF Summary (Expenditures continued...)



- Operating Expenses (continued...)
  - Supplies and Services plus \$1.9M
    - ► Finance \$714K (GAAP), Development Services plus \$650K, Police plus \$296K, City Clerk \$192K, Fire plus \$100K
- Transfer to offset prior period UUT revenues
- Overall increase of \$5M (including \$3M of one time) in FY 2017 Mid-Year less than half of the \$13.6M in increases requested at FY 2016 Mid-Year

### FY 2017 Mid-Year Operating Adjustment Summary



FY 2016 Actual Gap = \$855K FY 2017 Projected Gap = \$2.5M (down from \$4.4M as adopted)



### The Plan: Challenges and Next Steps

- Rising cost of Salaries
- Escalating CalPERS rates reduction of discount rate and required funding of UAL component for agencies
- Retiree Medical minimum contributions (OPEB ARC)
- Increasing Benefit costs associated with Medical & Dental
- ► The City will be completing an overhaul of the Plan.

  Anticipated completion Summer 2017. Because of this, other than changes to PERS there were no assumption changes.
