AUTHORIZATION FOR THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE \$16,700 FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL

WHEREAS, this grant money will be utilized to cover costs of operations designed to reduce the number of merchants selling alcohol to youths.

WHEREAS, the Hayward Police Department Special Investigations Bureau will provide additional underage decoy operations at licensed alcohol retail business to ensure compliance with state and local regulations.

WHEREAS, using local allocated funds combined with additional funds from the State of California Alcoholic Beverage Control grant, the Hayward Police Department will carry out at least five underage decoy operations, three "shoulder tap" operations and two IMPACT inspections. The IMPACT program is outlined by the State of California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control to help merchants deter crime.

WHEREAS, the Hayward Police Department's goal by conducting this enforcement is to prevent the sales of alcohol to youths from licensed retailers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That City Council authorizes the City Manager to: Accept and appropriate a total of \$16,700 from the State of California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control to fund enforcement operations designed to prevent the sales of alcohol from underaged individuals.
