Background

- July 9, 2019: Mayor Halliday, Voting Delegate & Councilmember Lamnin, Voting Alternate
- October 18, 2019: League of California Cities Annual Business Meeting
 - Member municipalities vote on League policy resolutions
- Two Resolutions Introduced at League Conference: The League is Considering two Resolutions this year

Resolution No.1 Undergrounding Utilities for Fire Safety

- Calls upon the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) to expand criteria for undergrounding utilities to include projects in Very High Fire Hazard Zones
- Increase funding for undergrounding projects to support the expanded criteria
- A response to the high fire risk posed by exposed energized utility lines

STAFF RECOMMENDATION: Support Resolution

Resolution No. 2 Working Internationally for Water Quality

- Calls on state and federal government to restore and adequately fund the U.S.-Mexico Border Water Infrastructure Program
- Asks governments to work cooperatively to address water quality issues resulting from transboundary waterways
- Solution focused on addressing untreated sewage, polluted sediment, and trash in the Tijuana River which flows from Mexico through California and flows to the ocean on the California coast
