RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE \$35,984.70 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE ALAMEDA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2020 BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT FOR HAYWARD POLICE DEPARTMENT OPERATIONS

WHEREAS, the Hayward Police Department has a long history of receiving Byrne Justice Assistance Grant funds to support police department operations; and,

WHEREAS, execution of a sub-recipient agreement is necessary to receive these funds;

WHEREAS, these funds require no local match and will be used to support criminal justice and community policing-related activities such as training, equipment, supplies, prevention and education programs, mental health programs, and other related law enforcement and corrections programs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward that the City Manager, City Attorney, and Chief of Police are hereby authorized and directed to negotiate and execute MOUs, sub-recipient agreements, and any supporting documents, with the Alameda County Sheriff's Office, for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2020 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant.

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Hayward that the City Manager is authorized to accept and appropriate the FY 2020 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant to the Byrne Grant Fund (Fund 820) in the amount of \$35,984.70.
