SUBJECT: Hayward Youth Commission: Adopt a Resolution Confirming the Appointment

and Reappointment of Hayward Youth Commission Members

RECOMMENDATION

That the City Council adopts a resolution (Attachment II) confirming the appointment to the Hayward Youth Commission of eight (8) voting members and eleven (11) alternate members, and the reappointment of five (5) continuing members.

SUMMARY

The City conducted its annual recruitment for the Hayward Youth Commission (HYC) between March 14, 2024, and May 30, 2024, and a panel of representatives from the three local agencies (City of Hayward, Hayward Area Recreation and Park District (HARD), and the Hayward Unified School District (HUSD)) reviewed sixty-one (61) applications and interviewed fifty-one (51) eligible applicants on June 7, 2024. The panel selected a total of nineteen (19) regular voting and alternate members. The same panel confirmed the reappointment of five (5) current members.

BACKGROUND

On June 7, 2024, an interview panel comprised of representatives from the three local public agencies (City of Hayward, HARD, and HUSD) interviewed fifty-one candidates to fill vacancies on the HYC. The agency representatives were: Council Member Ray Bonilla Jr. and Council Member Angela Andrews from the City of Hayward; Board Director Rick Hatcher and Board Director Sara Lamnin from HARD; and Board Clerk Dr. April Oquenda and Board Trustee Sara Prada from HUSD.




