RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ALLOW THE HAYWARD POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE APPLICATION PROCESS FOR THE ORGANIZED RETAIL THEFT PREVENTION GRANT SPONSORED THROUGH THE BOARD OF STATE AND COMMUNTIY CORRECTIONS

WHEREAS, the City of Hayward desires to participate in the Organized Retail Theft Prevention Grant Program funded through the State Budget Act and administered by the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC); and

WHEREAS, the Hayward Police Department intends to request up to \$850,000 of grant funding to enter into an agreement with FLOCK Safety to purchase 54 Flock Automated License Plate Reading Cameras, and 16 Flock Situational Awareness Cameras; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds requested will be for the purchase, installation, and a three year service agreement of said cameras; and

WHERAS, at the conclusion of the three-year service agreement, continued funding for all cameras purchased through the grant will come from the Police Departments CIP funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Manager be authorized on behalf of the City Council of the City of Hayward to submit the grant proposal for this funding and sign the Grant Agreement with the BSCC, including any amendments thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
