


***Feasibility of U.S. Customs Office

Background

- **Designated “national” general aviation airport**
- **Significant number of international flights**
- **Passengers clear customs at other Bay Area airports**
- **Tenant inquiries about customs**
- **Customs and Border Patrol (CBP) responsible**

International Destinations

Combined Annual Trips Outside of U.S. – 241



Options

- **User Fee Airport (UFA) – requires new facility**
- **Preclearance operations**



Next Steps

- **Staff submits formal proposal to CBP**
- **CBP inspects airport**
- **CBP provides technical design**
- **Staff obtains cost information**
- **Staff updates CAC**






Airport Operations vs. Complaints




Airport Operations vs. Exceedances




Complaint Totals by Households



Total Complaints vs. Exceedances




Monthly Exceedances: 2016 vs. 2017





Airport Operations vs. Complaints








Complaint Totals by Households
