1. Approval of Meeting Minutes from September 18, 2024

Action: Minutes reviewed and unanimously approved.

- 2. General Fund Budget Balancing Strategies
  - Finance Director Gonzales presented an overview of General Fund budget balancing strategies for discussion.
  - Councilmember Syrop Questions:
    - A. Are there potential savings if we do not fully fund our OPEB obligations?
    - B. Is the \$5-\$7 million for each Caltrans property or the entire amount from all the properties?
    - C. Do you have thoughts or reasons for keeping Caltrans sales in a separate fund from the General Fund?
    - D. What is the feasibility of the City researching and recommending progressive taxes?
  - Councilmember Bonilla Jr. Questions:
    - A. Can you provide information on City owned properties to sell?
    - B. When the City's investments earn money, do the funds get reinvested or do the funds go to the General Fund?
    - C. Can the committee discuss the Hayward Economic Development Corporation (HEDC) in January or February?

- 3. American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Analysis and Review
  - Finance Director Gonzales presented an update on the City's ARPA fund projects.
  - Councilmember Syrop Questions:
    - A. Why was the City unable to spend down the funds available in the legal services for the Evictions Program?
    - B. Can you provide insight on the merger of the outside firms involved in the legal services for Evictions Program?
  - Councilmember Bonilla Jr. Questions:
    - A. Can staff provide options to fund the First-Time Homebuyer Down Payment Assistance/Wealth-Building Program without utilizing General Fund dollars?
    - B. Will the reallocation of funds affect on-going projects?
  - Mayor Salinas Questions:
    - A. Do we have to return the unobligated and/or unspent \$3.6 million in ARPA funds to the federal government?
    - B. What amount will be reallocated to General Fund reserves?
