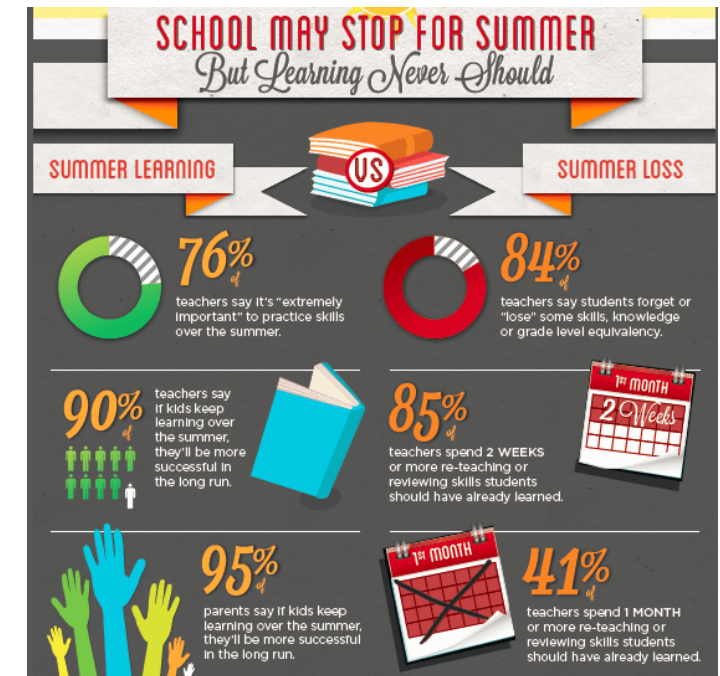
- Advance literacy and academic performance by engaging children and teens in reading and reading-related activities during the summer months.

# Summer Learning Loss

- Summer learning loss refers to the decline in academic skills students experience during extended breaks from school.
- Low-income and minority students are disproportionately affected due to limited access to resources and enrichment programs.
- The long-term effects of summer learning loss include lower graduation rates and reduced workforce readiness, impacting economic growth.
- Engagement in summer learning programs has shown promising results, with participants often showing gains in reading skills equivalent to an additional month of school. Such programs are also linked to higher graduation rates and improved self-esteem among students.

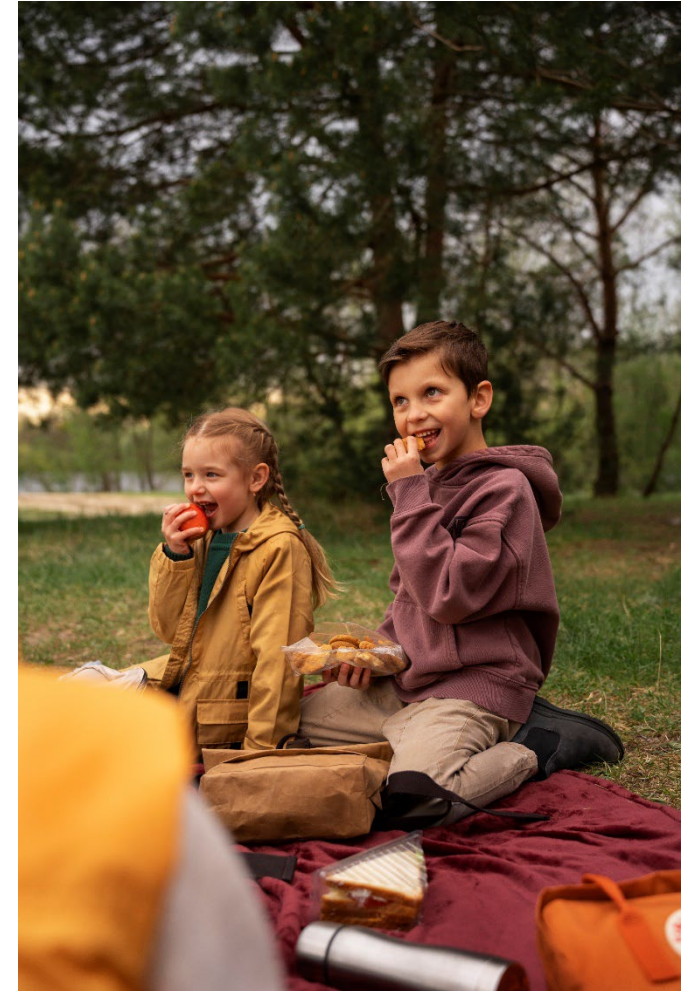

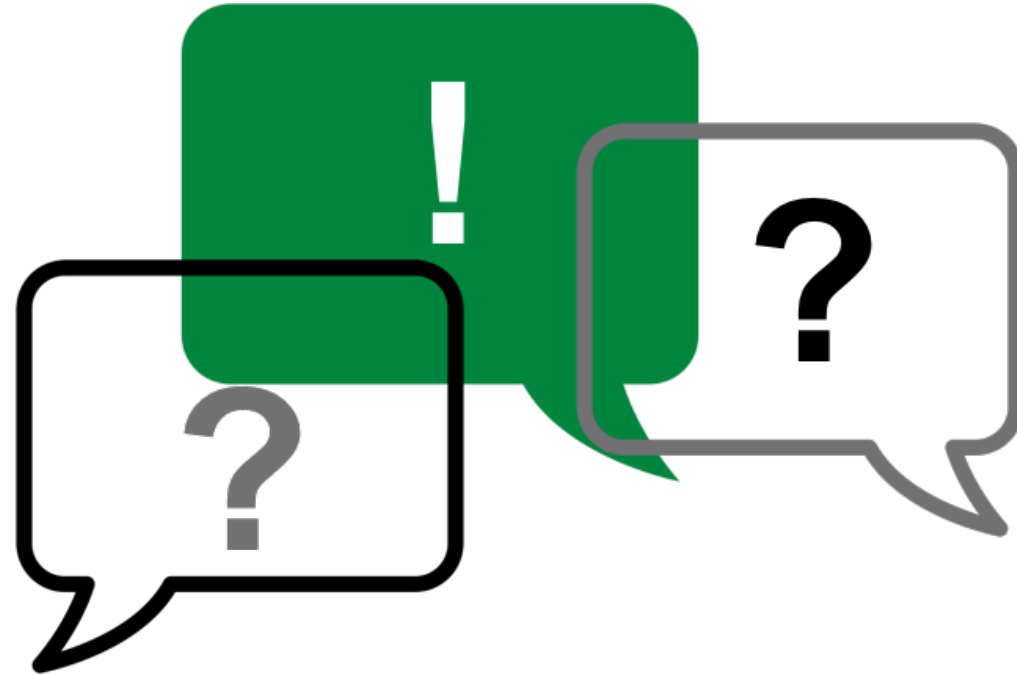

Dear Assemblymember Alvarez:

The Hayward Library Commission respectfully requests your support in assuring appropriate funding, in the 2026-27 State Budget, for the following critical community library services:

• **California Library Services Act – 6120-211-0001:**

In past years, this funding supported delivery services between libraries, allowing them to share over 5 million items annually. By sharing, libraries make more materials available and accessible to all residents, especially those in rural and isolated areas.

In addition, CLSA funds allowed the Hayward Public Library (HPL) to purchase shared eCollections (eBooks, eMagazines) which are used nearly 2 million times annually. With these funds Hayward Public Library has been able to provide shared resources and collections without the substantial cost of having to purchase each item.

Sufficient funding is needed to maintain this vitally important cost-effective program in community libraries.

**English As A Second Language (ESL) Instruction – 6120-213-0001:**

The most recent U.S. Census Bureau estimates show that about 61.8% of Hayward residents age 5 and older speak a language other than English at home. Clearly, many of our residents need ESL assistance.

The free ESL programs, in our libraries, provide a lifeline to those struggling with language barriers in school and in the job market. These programs include one on one tutoring, conversation circles, to improve fluency in speech, and citizenship application assistance.

By improving their English skills, our residents are able to complete job training programs, obtain GEDs, get better jobs and help educate their own children. This program truly has a ripple effect that improves the entire community and society, at a large.

With the ever increasing number of immigrants, it is essential that California increase investment in ESL services.

• **Lunch At The Library – 6120-140-0001:**

For years, Hayward Lunch at the Library program, in partnership with Hayward Unified School District (HUSD, has provide thousands of children with free lunches and books during the summer months. Prior to initiation of the Universal Lunches program, 59% of HUSD students were eligible, due to family income, for free and reduced lunches.

In FY 2025 HPL received a mere \$16,685. With that, we were able to provide over 1,500 free lunches and books. More funding is needed for HPL to continue this program, promoting literacy, helping HUSD to bridge the “summer slide,” and making meaningful efforts to combat food insecurity. Our libraries are an invaluable asset to all, but particularly, to those most in need. This innovative program can only continue with sufficient state funding.

In closing, the Hayward Library Commission seeks your support in assuring the continuation of these three vital community programs. We respectfully request increased funding for CLSA, ESL instruction and the Lunch at the Library programs.

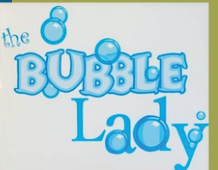

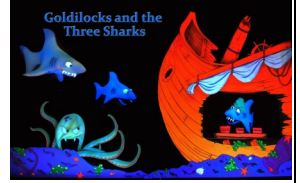
