AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH KIMLEY-HORN IN THE AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$1,600,000 AND FEHR & PEERS IN THE AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED \$950,000 FOR CONSULTING SERVICES FOR PHASE 1 OF THE HIGH INJURY NETWORK SAFETY PLAN, PROJECT NO. 06942 AND FOR THE DOWNTOWN SPECIFIC PLAN IMPLEMENTATION, PROJECT NO. 05237

WHEREAS, professional service assistance is needed for Phase 1 of the High Injury Network Safety Plan, Project No. 06942 and the Downtown Specific Plan Implementation, Project No. 05237; and

WHEREAS, the High Injury Network Safety Plan will help develop strategies to implement the Hayward Local Road Safety Plan and Vision Zero policy; and

WHEREAS, on October 18, 2024, four (4) valid proposals were received and then evaluated for the most qualified proposal. Kimley-Horn was ranked the highest with an average score of 86/100 and Fehr & Peers was ranked second-highest with an average score of 83/100 based on criteria established in the Request for Proposal 25-024; and

WHEREAS, the negotiated cost proposal is in the amount of \$1,600,000 for Kimley-Horn and \$950,000 for Fehr & Peers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward that the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute two separate professional services agreements with Kimley-Horn in a not-to-exceed amount \$1,600,000 and Fehr & Peers in a not-to-exceed amount \$950,000 for consulting services, in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.
