Dear Mayor, City Council, City Manager,

You should be advised that recently an inflammatory, skewed, and inaccurate online petition was distributed by leadership of the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Library group, telling lies about those of us trying to save the destruction of the old library building for re-use as a Creative Community Center. Please see below for specific corrections of the inaccuracies promulgated by the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Library group.

I have serious concerns about the leadership of the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Library group, based on these inaccuracies. I wonder what else has been exaggerated, skewed, and lied about in the process of getting the new library. This is not the way to invite public participation and keep people involved in the public process. It is not a good way to do public business.

I personally hope you will keep an open mind and allow the old library building to be retained for more discussion about its future use. I think the plaza in its current form, with a community use building on it, is fine. I think razing the building to have a large open space will attract more homeless, and you already have a plaza almost directly across the street in front of city hall.

The best idea I have heard, to keep both sides happy, would be to relocate the rainwater storage system away from the basement area and in a tank on either property; this would mean a brief delay in construction of the new library to allow plans to be re-drawn, but makes sense and would be easy.

Hayward has far too much history of tearing down its historic cultural resources. We need to be thoughtful about the older fabric of our community, as it is part of what makes us unique. Old buildings can be creatively rehabilitated and re-used, and can be an important part of a vibrant community.

Please read below for specific corrections to the inaccuracies promulgated in the recent petition by the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Library leadership.

**Correcting the Inaccuracies about Saving the Old Hayward Library**

*Quotes are from an online petition on Change.org promulgated by the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Library leadership.*

“Thanks to Hayward voters who in 2014 overwhelmingly approved Measure C by a 2-to-1 margin, the project is fully funded and we are poised to break ground on a beautiful, modern, environmentally sustainable new 21st Century Library and Heritage Plaza Arboretum for the entire Hayward community to enjoy for generations to come.”

*INACCURATE: “But now a small group of people have decided that they want the City Council to change the project at the last minute, essentially to cast aside and disregard the work done by thousands of Hayward residents who participated in the many public design workshops and surveys that were held over the past seven years.”*

FACT: People from numerous local organizations such as Hayward Arts Council, Sun Gallery, Chabot, College, the local art community, and the local maker/tech community, etc. are asking to retain the old library building for use as a Creative Community Center.

FACT: Multiple workshops were held about building a new library. Many people who participated in the workshops were repeat people, so we question whether “thousands” of people actually participated. But more importantly, we do know that people who voted for Measure C never knew that they would be supporting tearing down the old library building.

FACT: This does not have to be “either-or”; we can support a new library AND support saving the old Library building!

*INACCURATE: “These latecomers want to eliminate the Heritage Plaza Arboretum from the project. Not only would this deprive Hayward of its historic central plaza for all time, but it would actually increase the overall cost to taxpayers by up to \$8 million.”*

FACT: We support the Arboretum – we do not want to disturb the beautiful trees on the property. We just don’t want the old Library building torn down. Why would it cost up to \$8 million to avoid tearing down the old building? We have no knowledge of why this would cost \$8 million. In fact, it could save the City between \$5.2 million and \$8.8 million, which is the cost of tearing down the building and making a plaza.

*INACCURATE: “They also want to eliminate the rainwater storage system and throw away the chance to save 400,000 gallons of rainwater each year, during the worst drought in decades.”*

FACT: The recycling reservoir could be relocated near the new library where there is no building in the way and it is closer. Virtually all the specs except for distance would remain the same and building it would proceed on schedule

According to calculations, the payoff on this rainwater storage system would take about 600 years at current water costs in the city – you read correctly: 600 years! Is that the best use of over 5 million taxpayer dollars? This is not really about saving water, it is about getting a special plaque on the new library wall that certifies it as a green building. We



think a vibrant Creative Community Center is a better use of this space – and a better way to be “green” by creative re-use of a building loved by many.

*INACCURATE: “Why do they want to do this? Because they want the City Council to give them the old, deteriorating library building for free – a building which needs an estimated \$4 million to \$8 million in repairs, and which costs Hayward taxpayers over \$200,000 per year for upkeep alone – so this small group of people can use it for their own special interests.”*

FACT: We have not asked the City for anything – except not to tear down the old Library building! This may in fact save the City money – specifically, the \$5-8 million currently planned to tear down the old building and make a plaza. A plaza across from another plaza (in front of City Hall). A plaza where entertainment will not be heard due to traffic noise. A plaza with no restrooms. Do you think this plaza will attract positive influences? Do you think this is a good use of \$5-8 million of taxpayer money?

FACT: According to a current City Council Member, the City’s budget for maintenance and utilities for the old Library building is \$110,000. This is a budget item for BOTH the main library and Weeks Branch, and includes BOTH maintenance and utilities – so why is this number consistently inflated to \$200K? Where do they get their \$4-8 million figures for repair? These figures may have been fabricated in the effort to lobby for a new library. We are working on a budget for rehabilitation and reuse of the old library building as a Creative Community Center. We envision it to provide a place for art, creativity, and community work by local artists, artisans, craftsmen, creators, community members, and community organizations. When the new 21<sup>st</sup> Century Library is built, we believe that the old library building would be an excellent location for this **“Hayward Arts and Community Center.”**

FACT: Everyone benefits from access to art and creativity in an aesthetic and accessible place, and the Center would improve the community and help revitalize downtown Hayward. The Library Plaza would be enhanced by having a focal point. The Hayward Arts Council, Sun Gallery, A.R.T. Inc., individuals at HARD, members of the staff and faculty at Chabot College, and the Friends of the Arts at California State University East Bay, all support the creation of this center, which shows wide support on behalf of the community.

We have many people volunteering their time to make this happen, including art expertise, legal expertise, tech expertise, community organizing and grant writing. We plan to seek grants to rehab the building and run the space, as a coordinated effort among community members and agencies. This would be a positive thing for Hayward. Please support a vibrant, creative re-use of an existing building, rather than tearing down another historic building to leave another empty lot in Hayward. <http://www.savetheoldlibrary.org/>

Dear Council Member,

Let me tell you why I am writing this. In 2003, I received the Hayward Lion's Club Distinguished Citizen Award. In 2004, I received the Mayor John N. Pappas Humanitarian Award. In 2010, I was named a Hayward Hero by the Hayward Education Foundation for my work at the Hayward Adult School where I taught GED and Literacy for 22 years. For the past 15 years, I have been a tutor and on the Literacy Plus Council at the Hayward Library. Currently, I lead a Conversation Circle at the Hayward Library for students wanting to improve their English. I give you this background so you'll know of my desire to do good things for the community.

I walked door to door and worked at the phone bank asking people to vote for Measure C so the new library could be built. I donated money to the Measure C campaign. There was never any mention of tearing down the old library. Measure C says nothing about tearing down the old library or making a water cistern.

When I read the mean-spirited online petition distributed by the 21<sup>st</sup> Library group which is full of inaccuracies and spurious attacks on Save the Old Library people, I was shocked and hurt, but not surprised. Who wrote this petition? Why does one Council Member show records that indicate it costs less than one half of what the Librarian says it costs to run the library? Why is he saying these falsehoods? And we wonder why people don't get involved?

After my husband and I attended a reception to meet the architect for the new library, I was sent a letter inviting me to attend a New Library review session. When I phoned to say I'd attend, I was told I was no longer needed and could not go. What was that all about? It's ludicrous that the 21<sup>st</sup> Library petition says they "want it for their own special interests." What is this person talking about? Fear of retaliation against volunteer run organizations which require city funding could have dire effects. Do you want this?

Who are these "thousands" of people that approve of tearing down the old library to have a plaza at a minimum cost of \$5.2 million? A Hayward Post Office employee told me it will have to be called "The Park for Homeless People" (similar to the City Plaza in front of San Francisco City Hall) as we watched many souls wander around the library.

Why not appease both sides by relocating the water cistern away from the basement? It could be put on either property. This would mean a brief delay in starting construction on the new library while plans are re-drawn, but it would be easy and allow for a Task Force to report back to you on what would be in the best interests of the community.

**Dear Mayor and City Council,**

**We are writing to you as a coalition of thousands of Hayward community members and volunteers including Friends of Hayward Library and Committee to Protect Hayward's Future to ask you, the Mayor and City Council of Hayward, to approve the 21st Century Library and Heritage Plaza project and award the construction contract on September 15, 2015 with no last-minute changes to the design.**

**What we are asking you is very simple and straightforward.**

**We are asking you to honor the promises and commitments that were made to the Hayward community about the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Library and Heritage Plaza project.**

**We are asking you to uphold and affirm the contributions of thousands of Hayward residents who gave their time and effort to help create the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Library and Heritage Plaza project design.**

**We are asking you to follow through on the promise that was made to Hayward voters when they were asked to approve Measure C to, among other projects and services, help fund the construction of the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Library and Heritage Plaza project.**

**As you know, many people in Hayward have worked very hard over nearly 20 years to make the 21st Century Library and Heritage Plaza project a reality, including Friends of Hayward Library, Hayward City Council, the Committee to Protect Hayward's Future, and thousands of community-minded volunteers and residents like us.**

**Thanks to Hayward voters who in 2014 overwhelmingly approved Measure C by a 2-to-1 margin, the project is fully funded and we are poised to break ground on a beautiful, modern, environmentally**

sustainable new 21st Century Library and Heritage Plaza Arboretum for the entire Hayward community to enjoy for generations to come.

But now, a small group of people who have only recently emerged are lobbying the Mayor and City Council to make massive changes to the project at the last possible minute, to cast aside and disregard the work done by thousands of Hayward residents who participated in the many public design workshops and surveys that were held over the past seven years.

These latecomers basically want to eliminate the Heritage Plaza from the project and try to rehabilitate the old library building. Not only would this deprive Hayward of its historic central plaza for all time, but by the City's own estimates it would cost taxpayers up to \$8 million. They also want to eliminate the rainwater storage system and throw away the chance to save 400,000 gallons of rainwater each year, during the worst drought in decades.

According to their proposal they want the Mayor and City Council to attempt to rehabilitate the old library building – a building which according to the City's own estimates needs between \$4 million to \$8 million in repairs, and which costs Hayward taxpayers over \$300,000 per year for upkeep alone – all so this small group of people can use it for their own special interests.

Of greatest concern is that their proposal, if actually carried out, would clearly be disastrous to the entire project including the new library construction. Removing the plaza and attempting to rehabilitate the old library building instead of demolishing it - these are major changes. It would be the height of folly and irresponsibility to make such ill-advised changes at all, and especially at this very late stage in the project when literally millions of taxpayer dollars are at stake.

Making their proposed changes would significantly delay and endanger the entire project. Such major, unvetted, ill-conceived changes would raise the project cost dramatically. Several systems connecting the plaza to the library would have to be redesigned. Construction on the new building could not begin until the redesign was complete. The project would be delayed.

Construction costs are going up fast, and according to the City's own reports, even a few months of delay will cost millions of dollars on a project this size. And in addition to the millions of dollars in needed capital repairs, there's the ongoing cost of operating the old library building to consider: over \$300,000 per year according to City financial and administrative personnel who manage the City's operating budget – and this ongoing annual cost is expected to go up as the building continues to deteriorate over time.

It's not a question of simply "fixing" the old building. That question was fully reviewed and analyzed and discussed on multiple occasions throughout the various phases of the design process, particularly in 2008 and again in 2010, 2013 and 2014, and the conclusion was that the old building has simply reached the end of its serviceable lifespan. Some buildings eventually just wear out over time and have to be rebuilt - schools, office buildings - and the old library is one of them.

Then there's the public input to consider. The fact of the matter is that there were seven years of public design meetings and surveys during which all of this – including demolishing the old library – was discussed and considered by thousands of participating citizens, and according to the City's own reports the vast and overwhelming preference was to restore the plaza. And as you know, there was a vote of the people at the ballot last June which overwhelmingly approved Measure C funding for this project by a 2-to-1 margin.

Most recently, this same Mayor and City Council on May 26, 2015, voted to approve the 21st Century Library and Heritage Plaza project and to place it out to construction bid. The project you approved



included the new library construction, the old library demolition, and plaza restoration. Yes votes were cast by Mayor Halliday, Council Member Zermefio, Council Member Jones, Council Member Mendall, and Council Member Peixoto. The lone No vote was cast by Council Member Lamnin. Council Member Márquez recused herself because her family owns a restaurant less than one block from the construction site.

We've been over all of this ground before. There is a robust, democratic process for designing public buildings like this, and it has been honestly, transparently, and faithfully followed.

Please protect and save the project that thousands of Hayward residents worked so hard over so many years to create.

Please uphold and affirm the promises and commitments that were made to the people of Hayward.

Please don't capitulate to special interests by making the ill-advised, disastrous last-minute changes they are asking you to make to this project.

When you vote to approve the award of construction contract on September 15, 2015, please approve the project as-is, the WHOLE project including the demolition of the deteriorating old library, the complete renovation of the historic Heritage Plaza, and the installation of the underground rainwater storage tank, with no last-minute changes.

On September 15, 2015, we will present to you a petition bearing the signatures of over 1,000 Hayward residents asking you to take this very simple, straightforward action.



# San Francisco dumps MTBE; will others follow?

(AP) In terms of the overall market, gasoline for San Francisco's city vehicles isn't likely to have a huge impact. But the city-county supervisors' decision not to buy any gasoline containing the oxygenating additive MTBE (methyl tertiary butyl ether) for its own vehicles could have a significant political and legal impact.

MTBE you may remember, is the additive favored to meet Environmental Protection Agency standards that call for oxygenates in the gasoline in parts of California that don't meet EPA clean-air standards. The trouble is that it leaks easily into water supplies and stays a long time.

While the health effects are subject to controversy – some authorities claim a link to cancer and other diseases while others disagree – MTBE has a noxious odor that makes water virtually undrinkable.

California has moved to ban MTBE in gasoline beginning January 2003. Gov. Davis petitioned the feds to grant California a waiver from the EPA decree demanding that oxygenates be added to California gasoline since the most viable alternative is ethanol, made from corn by agribusiness giant Archer Daniels Midland with heavy subsidies. Earlier this year the Bush administration refused to grant the waiver.

But some authorities believe the EPA

oxygenate requirement is not an enforceable mandate at all. If California defied it on the credible grounds that requiring oxygenates could make pollution worse rather than better, the EPA might well back off.

Those forces carried the day in San Francisco.

San Francisco Supervisor Chris Daily, spurred by lobbyists for ethanol, began the move to ban MTBE a few weeks ago. But a coalition of environmental and community groups mobilized and convinced him that the EPA "mandate" for oxygenates was not enforceable.

So the resolution the San Francisco supervisors passed (Oct. 22) did not include language giving preference to ethanol. In a letter to the group Communities for a Better Environment, Daily praised the group's "tireless efforts" and said the final ordinance "will move San Francisco closer to protecting our water quality by phasing out MTBE quickly, without creating a massive giveaway to special interests who produce ethanol." ...

There's irony in the controversy. Most of the MTBE that got into California water supplies came through leaky tanks, most of which have been replaced. So the problem may not be as widespread as some fear.

# **A Solution To Global Warming Does More Harm Than Good**

As Californians face mandatory water restrictions due to a severe drought, growing biofuels – long considered a solution to climate change – may actually be worse for water shortages than the effects of global warming itself. According to a new peer-reviewed study from the Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences, growing biofuels and the policies in place to increase their use are worse for drought than global warming.

California is the biggest corn ethanol consumer out of all 50 states, guzzling more than 1.2 billion gallons of biofuel in 2012. By comparison, the federal mandate requiring ethanol be blended into fuel and supplying California with ethanol-laced gas consumed 42 billion gallons of water in 2012 alone.

What's worse is that recent reports suggest the water used to supply energy to California has increased four-fold over the past twenty years, with the bulk of water used for biofuels grown in the Midwest to supply our car-loving culture with fuel.

The quandary facing California shows how the Renewable Fuel Standard (RFS) is broken and riddled with unintended consequences. Originally intended to provide an environmentally-friendly and homegrown alternative to fossil fuels, the RFS has proven to do more harm than good when it comes to global warming, worse on emissions and now, on water supply. The latest study once again shows that ethanol will do little to counteract the effects of climate change, saying that if biofuels aren't "designed with careful attention to water resources" their use could increase the magnitude, area, and

frequency of droughts.

Consider that in order to grow corn for ethanol, an estimated 4,000 gallons of water is needed per bushel of corn. By the year 2030, if the mandate remains unchanged, almost one in 10 gallons of the water consumed in the United States could go toward growing biofuels. That's more water than the entire American population consumes today.

With Republican presidential candidates headed to Simi Valley for their second debate on September 16, now would be a great time to ask them what they would do to ease the drought and if doing away with the ethanol mandate is part of their solution. It should be. Only a handful of candidates, including Gov. Jeb Bush and Sen. Ted Cruz, have come out against the RFS. Many others have refused to denounce the corn ethanol mandate despite overwhelming evidence that corn ethanol is failing to deliver on its promise, and exacerbating rather than easing global warming.

California's drought doesn't have a quick fix. But if policymakers want to make progress, the RFS is a good place to start. Some lawmakers have gotten on board. This year, legislation was introduced in both the House and the Senate to reform or repeal the corn ethanol mandate. Our own Senator Diane Feinstein co-wrote a bill with Senator Pat Toomey of Rhode Island to eliminate the corn ethanol mandate altogether. I applaud both senators for taking the proper action needed to get our water supply back on track. The rest of Congress – and the presidential candidates – must now get on board and fix the broken RFS.

# Gov. Jerry Brown decries 'political pollution' on climate change

Last week, Gov. Jerry Brown was struggling in Sacramento with some of his fellow Democrats who refused to support his goal of slashing gasoline use on state roads.

But on Tuesday in Los Angeles, where he attended a summit on climate change with American and Chinese leaders, he was targeting Republicans.

Brown described "political pollution" in Washington and said the refusal of the party's presidential candidates to tackle global warming is "nothing less than a dereliction of duty."

"They have failed to respond to a profoundly serious threat," the governor said.

Republican presidential candidates are gathering at the Reagan Library for a debate on Wednesday.

A Republican mayor from Indiana, James Brainard, who was attending the event, said he wants his party to take a firmer environmental stance.

"Our leadership is listening to too much of the pollution coming off talk radio and the TV shows," he said.

Last week, Brown and Senate leader Kevin de León (D-Los Angeles) dropped a proposal for reducing petroleum use by half over the next 15 years. The rest of the legislation, which increases renewable energy and energy efficiency, was passed by the Legislature, but lawmakers were not able to get enough support among Democrats for the gasoline component.

Brown said he would use state programs and regulatory authority that's already in place

to chip away at how much gas Californians burn.

"It would have been great to have that codification," he said. "But we're still on track."

When it comes to getting more action on climate change, Brown said, "We've got to win the minds and hearts all over California."

The summit, hosted by Mayor Eric Garcetti, was a chance for local leaders from the U.S. and China to discuss ways to lower greenhouse gas emissions.

"It's up to us to model the pathways," Brown said.

Los Angeles and the Chinese city of Zhenjiang on Tuesday signed an international pledge spearheaded by the governor to set stringent climate change targets for 2050.

# *US, China Pair Up on Climate Change*

WHITE HOUSE— Amid questions about China's currency manipulation and its behavior in cyber space, U.S. administration officials are highlighting common areas of interest as President Barack Obama prepares to welcome his Chinese counterpart Xi Jinping to the White House later this month.

"Whether it's on climate issues or confronting Iran over their nuclear program, we have been able to effectively coordinate with the Chinese to advance the interests of the citizens of both of our countries," White House Press Secretary Josh Earnest told reporters Monday.

Cooperation on climate change will be the focus of the two-day U.S.-China Climate Leaders Summit in Los Angeles Tuesday, where officials from both countries will share best practices for reducing carbon emissions.

The meeting is a follow up to the joint announcement on climate change made during Obama's visit to Beijing in November of last year.

## **US goals**

The United States announced a goal of reducing carbon emissions by 26-28 percent below its 2005 level by 2025. China committed to peak their carbon emissions by 2030.

"This year needs to be a year of implementation, and a year when our two countries demonstrate our commitment to implementing and executing against those goals with ambitious, concrete steps to reduce our carbon emissions in a way that moves our economies forward," Senior White House Advisor Brian Deese said.

During the California summit, cities, states and provinces from the United States and China will sign a climate leaders declaration, agreeing to take parallel steps to address climate change.

## **Chinese goals**

Chinese cities that have set peak years for carbon dioxide emissions earlier than the national goal of 2030 have formed an alliance as part of the declaration.

"This is important because the commitment to early peaking by so many mega cities in China highlights the fact that the country as a whole is moving to achieve its national goal as early as possible," Deese told reporters in a press call

## **Monday.**

The White House says China's Beijing and Guangzhou have committed to peak their carbon dioxide emissions by the end of or around 2020. Officials say commitments by Chinese cities and provinces represent approximately 1.2 gigatons of annual carbon emissions, about a quarter of China's urban total, and roughly the same level of emissions as Japan or Brazil.

## **California**

American cities, counties and states are making their own commitments. California has set a goal of reducing emissions by 80-90 percent below 1990 levels by 2050 and the U.S. city of Seattle has pledged to become carbon-neutral by 2050.

The summit will also focus on cooperation on a local level with Los Angeles and the Chinese cities of Shenzhen and Guangdong sharing ideas on the construction of green buildings, while exploring ways to expand trade in clean energy.

"The commitments that the Chinese and American cities are taking as a part of this summit are a very important component of our broader efforts by our two countries to deepen climate cooperation and to show that the two largest emitters in the world are taking seriously our obligations to meet the ambitious goals we set out last year," Deese said.

# California's Climate Change Revolt

Democrats reject green schemes that raise energy costs for the non-rich.

The environmental lobby has tried to turn climate change into a social justice issue even though its anticarbon policies disproportionately harm the poor. Honest Democrats are starting to admit this, as we saw in this week's stunning revolt in the California legislature.

Jerry Brown doesn't have much to show for his second turn in Sacramento, and of late he has focused his legacy attention on reducing carbon emissions. The Governor hailed California as a model of green virtue at the Vatican this summer and had hoped to flaunt sweeping new anticarbon regulations at the U.N.'s climate-change summit in Paris this year.

But now his party has mutinied. Democrats hold near supermajorities in both legislative chambers with 52 of 80 seats in the Assembly. Yet this week 21 Democratic Assembly members representing middle- and low-income communities—including 11 blacks and Latinos—joined Republicans to kill a bill mandating a cut in state greenhouse gas emissions to 80% below 1990 levels by 2050.

Democrats also forced Mr. Brown to scrap a measure that would have given the California Air Resources Board plenary authority to reduce statewide oil consumption in vehicles by half by 2030. Imagine the EPA without the accountability. "One of the implications probably would have been higher gas prices," noted Democratic Assemblyman Jim Cooper. "Who does it impact the most? The middle class and low-income folks."

Many Democrats demanded that the legislature get an up-or-down vote on the board's proposed regulations before they take effect. Yet the Governor and Senate liberals wouldn't abide constraints on the board's powers.

The defeat is all the more striking for the failure of appeals to green moral superiority. Liberal groups targeted Catholic Democrats with ads featuring Pope Francis. Mr. Brown demonized oil companies for selling a "highly destructive" product.

The most morally destructive product in California these days is green government. Take the 33% renewable electricity mandate. Since 2011 solar energy has increased more than 10-fold while wind has nearly doubled. But during this period electricity rates have jumped 2.18 cents per kilowatt hour—four times the national average. Inland residents and energy-intensive businesses have been walloped the most.

California's cap-and-trade program has also hurt manufacturers, power plants and oil refiners, which are required to purchase permits to emit carbon. Between 2011 and 2014, California's manufacturing employment increased by 2% compared to 6% nationwide, according to the federal Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Cap and trade has also raised fuel costs, though its effect is hard to isolate from other environmental mandates. The Western States Petroleum Association last year projected that cap and trade would add 16 to 76 cents per gallon to the retail

price of gas based on data from the Air Resources Board.

In 2006 Californians paid about 23 cents more per gallon than the national average due to higher gas taxes and the state's reformulated fuel regulations. The price premium increased to 41 cents last year and spiked to \$1.14 in May after several in-state refineries experienced problems. The average gas price in California is now \$3.22 and \$3.41 in the Los Angeles metro region (where a couple of refineries are undergoing maintenance) compared to \$2.36 nationwide.

California's low-carbon fuel standard will jack up gas prices even more. This anticarbon policy requires refiners to cut their fuel's "lifecycle" carbon emissions including transport to market by 10% by 2020. The goal is to boost California biofuels. However, there aren't enough commercially available "advanced" biofuels to meet the targets, so fuel blenders will have to buy regulatory credits.

The chief beneficiaries of the Golden State's green government have been the well-to-do, while low- and middle-income Californians have borne most of the regulatory costs. The Bay Area and Los

Angeles regions account for 80% of the state's electric car rebates compared to the San Joaquin Valley's 2%.

Liberals in Sacramento have promised to spend cap-and-trade revenues on car-sharing programs, low-emissions public transit and electric-car charging stations in low-income communities. But then they sock it to these drivers with regulations that raise gasoline prices.

Meantime, while job growth in the Bay Area is booming, unemployment remains high in the rest of the state. The unemployment rate is 3.8% in San Francisco and 2.9% in Palo Alto. It's 10.4% in Fresno, 8.8% in San Bernardino and 9.6% in the refining hub of Carson—nearly four percentage points higher than in December 2007.

After this week's defeat, Mr. Brown vowed to use regulation to end-run the legislature. "We don't have a declaration in statute, but we have absolutely the same authority," he declared. President Obama has taught him well. "We're going forward. The only thing different is my zeal has been intensified to a maximum degree." Vengeance is his, and the Governor will make hard-up Californians pay for their sins of emission

**Brown gives ground on climate bill, but vows 'life-and-death struggle' with Big Oil**

"I'd say oil has won this skirmish, but they lost the bigger battle because I am more determined than ever," Brown said.

With the petroleum reduction piece now removed from the legislation, Senate Bill 350 would still give power to the California Air Resources Board to raise energy efficiency standards in new buildings by 50 percent and derive half of the state's power from renewable sources by 2030.

The 50 percent cut to petroleum was not a mandated reduction of gasoline use, as some of the opposition had characterized it. It was a target that the air board would follow as the agency wrote and administered its emission reduction programs. Nonetheless, the oil industry — along with representatives from a handful of other industries — feared the law would raise costs on businesses and consumers.

"Our members come at this from the standpoint that this would increase costs exponentially for them. They are still

worried about the other two (parts) of the bill," said Ken Devore, a lobbyist with the California chapter of the National Federation of Independent Business.

While addressing reporters Wednesday, Brown did not distinguish between oil interests and Assembly members sympathetic to their viewpoint. He said his opposition had offered a compromise under which the oil piece would remain in the bill but legislators would oversee all major programmatic decisions by CARB. Brown, along with Assembly Speaker Toni Atkins and Senate Leader Kevin de León, said they refused to weaken the agency's authority.

The governor vowed to continue to fight for the standard, and raised the idea of going through the initiative process. "This is a life-and-death struggle, and it's not going to be finished in six months or even six years," he said. The ultimate goal is to "change the very basis of our industrial economy, and I think we're making tremendous progress."

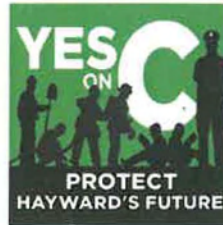

We are writing to you as a coalition of thousands of Hayward community members and volunteers including Friends of Hayward Library and Committee to Protect Hayward's Future to ask you, the Mayor and City Council of Hayward, to approve the 21st Century Library and Heritage Plaza project and award the construction contract on September 15, 2015 with no last-minute changes to the design.

What we are asking you is very simple and straightforward.

As you know, many people in Hayward have worked very hard over nearly 20 years to make the 21st Century Library and Heritage Plaza project a reality, including Friends of Hayward Library, Hayward City Council, the Committee to Protect Hayward's Future, and thousands of community-minded volunteers and residents like us.

Thanks to Hayward voters who in 2014 overwhelmingly approved Measure C by a 2-to-1 margin, the project is fully funded and we are poised to break ground on a beautiful, modern, environmentally

sustainable new 21st Century Library and Heritage Plaza Arboretum for the entire Hayward community to enjoy for generations to come.

But now, a small group of people who have only recently emerged are lobbying the Mayor and City Council to make massive changes to the project at the last possible minute, to cast aside and disregard the work done by thousands of Hayward residents who participated in the many public design workshops and surveys that were held over the past seven years.

These latecomers basically want to eliminate the Heritage Plaza from the project and try to rehabilitate the old library building. Not only would this deprive Hayward of its historic central plaza for all time, but by the City's own estimates it would cost taxpayers up to \$8 million. They also want to eliminate the rainwater storage system and throw away the chance to save 400,000 gallons of rainwater each year, during the worst drought in decades.

According to their proposal they want the Mayor and City Council to attempt to rehabilitate the old library building – a building which according to the City's own estimates needs between \$4 million to \$8 million in repairs, and which costs Hayward taxpayers over \$300,000 per year for upkeep alone – all so this small group of people can use it for their own special interests.

Of greatest concern is that their proposal, if actually carried out, would clearly be disastrous to the entire project including the new library construction. Removing the plaza and attempting to rehabilitate the old library building instead of demolishing it - these are major changes. It would be the height of folly and irresponsibility to make such ill-advised changes at all, and especially at this very late stage in the project when literally millions of taxpayer dollars are at stake.

Making their proposed changes would significantly delay and endanger the entire project. Such major, unvetted, ill-conceived changes would raise the project cost dramatically. Several systems connecting the plaza to the library would have to be redesigned. Construction on the new building could not begin until the redesign was complete. The project would be delayed.

Construction costs are going up fast, and according to the City's own reports, even a few months of delay will cost millions of dollars on a project this size. And in addition to the millions of dollars in needed capital repairs, there's the ongoing cost of operating the old library building to consider: over \$300,000 per year according to City financial and administrative personnel who manage the City's operating budget – and this ongoing annual cost is expected to go up as the building continues to deteriorate over time.

It's not a question of simply "fixing" the old building. That question was fully reviewed and analyzed and discussed on multiple occasions throughout the various phases of the design process, particularly in 2008 and again in 2010, 2013 and 2014, and the conclusion was that the old building has simply reached the end of its serviceable lifespan. Some buildings eventually just wear out over time and have to be rebuilt - schools, office buildings - and the old library is one of them.

Then there's the public input to consider. The fact of the matter is that there were seven years of public design meetings and surveys during which all of this – including demolishing the old library – was discussed and considered by thousands of participating citizens, and according to the City's own reports the vast and overwhelming preference was to restore the plaza. And as you know, there was a vote of the people at the ballot last June which overwhelmingly approved Measure C funding for this project by a 2-to-1 margin.

Most recently, this same Mayor and City Council on May 26, 2015, voted to approve the 21st Century Library and Heritage Plaza project and to place it out to construction bid. The project you approved

included the new library construction, the old library demolition, and plaza restoration. Yes votes were cast by Mayor Halliday, Council Member Zermeño, Council Member Jones, Council Member Mendall, and Council Member Peixoto. The lone No vote was cast by Council Member Lamnin. Council Member Márquez recused herself because her family owns a restaurant less than one block from the construction site.

We've been over all of this ground before. There is a robust, democratic process for designing public buildings like this, and it has been honestly, transparently, and faithfully followed.
