ORDINANCE NO. 20-

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE HAYWARD 2040 GENERAL PLAN ESTABLISHING NEW VEHICLE MILES TRAVELED (VMT) CEQA THRESHOLDS AND UPDATED GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSION (GHG) REDUCTION GOALS

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAYWARD DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Provisions</u>. The City Council incorporates by reference the findings contained in Resolutions No. 20-__ and No. 20-__ approving the General Plan Amendments establishing new Vehicle Miles Traveled (VMT) thresholds for California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) analysis and establishing new greenhouse gas emission reduction goals.

<u>Section 2</u>. The Hayward 2040 General Plan is hereby amended as detailed in the attached Exhibit A, introduced herewith and as specifically shown in this Ordinance.

Section 3. Severance. Should any part of this Ordinance be declared by a final decision by a court or tribunal of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, invalid, or beyond the authority of the City, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance, which shall continue in full force and effect, provided that the remainder of the Ordinance, absent the unexcised portion, can be reasonably interpreted to give effect to the intentions of the City Council.

<u>Section 4</u>. <u>Effective Date</u>. In accordance with the provisions of Section 620 of the City Charter, the Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
