WHEREAS, the California for All Animals Open Arms Challenge grant, administered through the UC Davis Koret Shelter Medicine Program, has made funds available for programs and processes that are inclusive of all areas and members of our community.

WHEREAS, the UC Davis Koret Shelter Medicine Program has awarded the Hayward Police Department's Animal Services Bureau \$5,000 to fund professional translation services.

WHEREAS, using funds from the California for All Animals Open Arms Challenge grant, the Hayward Animal Services Bureau will translate commonly distributed materials related to services provided and resources available into Spanish and Chinese.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward that the City manager is hereby authorized and directed to accept and appropriate \$5,000 in funding from the University of California on behalf of its Davis Campus School of Veterinary Medicine's Koret Shelter Program for use by the Hayward Police Department's Animal Services Bureau.
