- a. Literacy Council Report
 - Presentation led by Didacus Ramos
 - Explored GoFundMe and Facebook Fundraising in the past
 - Quarterly Newsletters (digital and hardcopy) have had more of a response.
 - The library provides the tutors for the literacy programs
 - Literacy Plus council was able to adopt a budget that will help bridge some of the gaps for us to maintain literacy programs for FY26
- b. Adult Literacy & ESL Services Report
 - Presentation led by Jessie Wu
 - The Basic English class is for true beginners and is held in person. Actively working on offering additional sessions due to the high demand.

- Currently meeting once a week for one hour.
- Volunteer instructors do not need to be fluent in other languages. Program assistants make it aware if someone doesn't speak any English
- In general ESL services have limitations such as limited volunteers, staff time, and facility availability
- The staff creating the content are TESOL trained
- Intensive training for ESL Volunteers
- AI has been incorporated in tutoring, for example, a ChatGPT workshop has been carried out in the past, but ultimately people want to be able to connect and communicate with other people.
 - The library is also moving very carefully with any AI backed partners due to the current political environment particularly around immigrants.
