**RECOMMENDATION**

That Council adopts a resolution appointing Ms. Isabel Pimental to the Community Services Commission to fulfill the unexpired term of Mr. Ernesto Sarmiento Jr., which will expire on September 30, 2021. Ms. Pimental shared with staff that she works for Mercy Housing. Mercy Housing contracts with Spectrum to provide their Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) to their residents. The City of Hayward provides funding to Spectrum to provide meals for seniors through the Community Agency Funding process. The City Attorney's Office determined that Ms. Pimental is able to serve on the Community Services Commission and does not have a conflict of interest because Mercy Housing does not benefit from the funding received from the City of Hayward.
