RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MODIFICATION OF THE CITY ATTORNEY’S EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the City of Hayward and the City Attorney, Michael Lawson entered into an employment agreement on June 23, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the employment agreement will expire on June 30, 2016 unless renewed by the parties on or before June 30, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to modify the agreement to include equity adjustments capped at fifteen percent, paid in two equal installments in FY 2016 and FY 2017, CalPERS cost sharing in the total amount of three percent (3%), phased in one percent (1%) in FY 2016, FY 2017, and FY 2018, one time vacation cash out of up to 160 hours in FY 2016 and 40 hours in FY 2017, a monthly personal equipment allowance of \$450.00, and health and wellness reimbursement equivalent to \$100 (\$1,200); and

WHEREAS, the City Manager agrees to the same employees savings commitment that applies to the City’s unrepresented executive employees for Fiscal Year 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward that the Council hereby approves the modification of the Attorney’s employment agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk, and authorizes the Mayor to execute the agreement on behalf of the City Council.
