

# MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING OF THE CITY OF HAYWARD

#### **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Mr. Peter Alexander, Hayward resident, submitted a document for the record and spoke about how Sergeant Scott Lunger was killed in the line of duty.

Miss Brenda Vila, Hayward resident and Council Member Márquez' intern, commended the City Council for its service to the community and spoke about the need for activities or a community center for young adults.

# BOARDS/COMMISSIONS/COMMITTEES/KEEP HAYWARD CLEAN & GREEN TASK FORCE INTERVIEWS

City Clerk Lens and members of the City Council discussed the logistics for the interviews.

The City Council interviewed eighteen applicants from a pool of forty-three qualified applications received by the City Clerk. Twenty-one applicants were pre-selected by the City Council, one applicant withdrew his application and three applicants did not interview.

At the conclusion of the interviews, the City Council identified twenty-one individuals for service on the Community Services Commission (4), Personnel Commission (3), Library Commission (1), Planning Commission (2), and Keep Hayward Clean and Green Task Force (11). Eleven individuals were selected by the City Council on July 28, 2015, and ten were interviewed on July 22, 2015 and recommended for appointment by the Keep Hayward Clean and Green Task Force Subcommittee. The formal appointment and swearing-in of the twenty-one individuals would occur at the Council meeting on September 15, 2015.

A letter from Glad Tidings Community Development Board Member Ownes regarding the street name change of Forselles Way to Glad Tidings Way was distributed to the City Council.
