AUTHORIZATION FOR THE CITY MANAGER TO APPROPRIATE \$10,203 PER FISCAL YEAR FOR THREE CONSECUTIVE YEARS (TOTAL OF \$30,609) FROM THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR ENFORCEMENT OF ILLEGAL TOBACCO SALES

WHEREAS, Illegal underage tobacco use in Hayward is sustained by license retail shops selling tobacco products to youths.

WHEREAS, The Hayward Police Department Special Investigations Bureau will provide additional underage decoy operations at licensed tobacco retail business to ensure compliance with state and local regulations.

WHEREAS, Using funds from the Department of Justice grant, the Hayward Police Department will carry out four underage decoy operations throughout each fiscal year for the next three continuous years.

WHEREAS, The Hayward Police Department’s goal by conducting this enforcement is to prevent the sales of tobacco products from licensed retailers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward that the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to appropriate a total of \$30,609 from the awarded Department of Justice grant to fund underage tobacco decoy operations.
