*Assumes 100 lineal foot minimum frontage along right-of-way. Additional costs for internal perimeter fencing – which could be chain link fencing per the proposed regulations, are not shown in this calculation.

**There is a \$600 production fee per order for Lace Fence because each order is custom made.

*** Fence Screen is overlaid on chain link fences so this cost assumes \$30 per lineal foot for chain link with the added cost for a standard printed Fence Screen. Custom printed Fence Screens are also available.

**** Labor costs are assumed to be generally similar among the various fence types. In some the posts go in faster and others the fabric goes up faster. The union/prevaling hourly wage would be \$150 per hour.
