### 6:45 PUBLIC COMMENTS

Melissa Milleman, Chair of the Keep Hayward Clean and Green Task Force, wanted to invite all HYC members to come to their cleanups. She expressed her desire to see the faces of HYC members at cleanup events and that participants could also receive credit for community service hours. Participants can expect to clean up parks and streets. Clean-up events meet monthly on the 4th Saturday at 8:30 am at various locations. The committee will be meeting on January 20th. They clean up the Weekes park once a month and also have volunteer opportunities 7 days a week, 24 hours a day in 2 locations. Participants can expect to help with laundry, serve food, etc.

Department serves the community through resources such as the 21st Century Library and Learning Center (Downtown Library), the Weekes Branch Library, Curbie (Bookmobile), and a Virtual Branch (open 24/7). She then spoke about all the amazing services provided at the Hayward Public Library such as: Library Cards for all Middle School & High school students, Tours and Programs in English, Spanish, and Mandarin, Homework Centers, High School Diplomas, and much more. Even the Virtual Branch of the library provides many resources that can help students in their endeavors such as Homework help from live tutors, Test Prep & Tutorials, Millions of ebooks, audiobooks, streaming movies & music, free passes to museums, zoos, and yet again, much much more. The Hayward Public Library even has its own makerspace. Within the makerspace, there are Laser Cutters, 3d Printers, Die-cutting Machines, CNC carving machines, Heat Presses, Wide-format Printers, Sticker Makers, and Sewing Machines. The Library even has a section for “things,” not just books! In this section, you can check out Ukuleles, Telescopes, and much more. With these resources, Jayanti hopes that the library will become a place beyond reading, a place where people can explore anything they want. The library even offers opportunities for students to make a difference in the Hayward community while also gaining community service hours through opportunities such as the Teen Volunteer Book Reviewers Program, which can be worked on from home.
