RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO REALLOCATE \$100,000 IN FUNDING PREVIOUSLY ALLOCATED TO THE HAYWARD FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR A DRONE PROJECT TO FUND A PROPOSAL FROM THE FIRE DEPARTMENT'S HEALTH AND WELLNESS COMMITTEE FOR PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT CLEANING AT AN ESTIMATED COST OF \$70,000, RETURNING \$30,000 TO MEASURE C FUND 406

WHEREAS, the Hayward Fire Department no longer seeks to purchase drones as initially proposed in the FY25 CIP project summaries;

WHEREAS, the department is seeking to be compliant with National Fire Protection Agency (NFPA) standards for PPE cleaning and sanitation, and seeks to reappropriate funding rather than seek funding outside of the planned budget;

WHEREAS, this proposal would result in a return of \$30,000 to the Measure C open fund balance, reducing the department ask from the existing \$100,000 to \$70,000. This funding will pivot to expenses related to cleaning services, maintenance, inspection, and cleaning equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Hayward that the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to reappropriate \$70,000 of the existing \$100,000 drone project funding to a new project fund that will be utilized for Hayward Fire Department fire personnel PPE cleaning and maintenance.
