- When joining by phone, click *9 to raise a hand to speak. Press *6 to unmute. We kindly request speakers to mute or turn down the meeting video when it is their opportunity to speak as it may cause interference with the speaker system.

RESULTS IN THE NUMBERS

The City Council allocated \$2 Million of the ARPA dollars to be used for Economic Recovery efforts for the business and workforce community.

BUSINESSES ASSISTED

179

Through the ARPA programs, the Economic Development Division was able to provide financial assistance to 179 different indepently owned small businesses located throughout the community.



Business Growth

174%

Gross Receipts of participating businesses in 2024 compared to 2021 at the start of the programs 156%

Gross Receipts of participating businesses in 2024 compared to pre-pandemic levels in 2019

In 2019, the gross receipts from the participating businesses was at \$51.7 Million. That number dropped to \$46.5 Million in 2021. At the end of the ARPA Economic Recover programs, the gross receipts of all participating businesses is at \$81 Million.


The participating small businesses employ over 2,700 employees to run their businesses. The Economic Recovery programs have assisted many of these businesses to be able to grow and keep their employees

Continue the Influencer Marketing program utilizing the additional \$100,000 allocated to the program in 2025.


