The City Council convened in closed session on December 17, 2024, at 5:30 p.m., with all members present and Council Member Andrews absent and no public speakers, regarding four items: 1) conference with counsel pursuant to Government Code section 54956.9, legal regarding Ierrv Schilling v. City Attorney Lawson added that pursuant to Government Code section 54954.2(b)(2), the Council unanimously added, with Council Member Roche moving and Council Member Syrop seconding, discussion of appointment and employment of public employment, to wit: City Manager; and the Council took no reportable action.
