The City Council convened in closed session on March 18, 2025, at 5:30 p.m., with all members present and no public speakers, regarding four items: 1) Conference with legal counsel pursuant to Government Code section 54956.9(d)(1), regarding Blickenstaff vs. City of Hayward, et al. Case No. 21-cv-09952-AMO (US District Court, Northern District); 2) Conference with legal counsel pursuant to Government Code section 54956.9(d)(1) regarding Ghali et al v. City of Hayward, US District Court, Northern District of California Case 3:25-cv-01116; 3) Conference with labor negotiators pursuant to Government Code Section 54957.6, regarding all labor groups; and 4) public employment pursuant to Government Code section 54957(b)(1) regarding City Attorney and City Clerk.

City Attorney Lawson indicated that the City Council discussed Items 2 and 3, gave direction, but took no reportable action. Regarding Item 2, City Attorney Lawson reported that the City Council unanimously approved, with Council Member Syrop moving and Council Member Zermeño seconding, settlement in the amount of \$500,000, with the City contributing \$250,000 from budgeted funds, and the City's insurance partners contributing \$250,000. Mayor Salinas announced the City Council discussed Item 4, but took no reportable action.

City Attorney Lawson announced that the City Council unanimously approved to convene in closed session on March 8, 2025, pursuant to Government Code sections 54954.2(b)(2) and 54957.
