RECOMMENDATION

That the Council adopts the Ordinance introduced on October 11, 2022.

SUMMARY

This item entails adoption of an Ordinance amending Chapter 10, Article 1 (Zoning Ordinance) of the Hayward Municipal Code, introduced on October 11, 2022, by Council Member Salinas.

BACKGROUND

The Ordinance was introduced by Council Member Salinas at the October 11, 2022, special meeting of the City Council with the following vote:

The motion included an amendment to the conditions of approval requiring additional trees. The condition of approval, found in the ordinance's companion resolution (Resolution 22-251), was updated by adding a new Condition of Approval No. 32 to read as follows.

LANDSCAPING

• 32. As amended by the City Council, the number of trees on site shall be increased to 22.
