- October 5-11
- Current list of Banned books on ALA
- Librarians are working on curating a list of banned books
  - The library services all populations – Books aren't separated by age but there are separate genres.
- Themes & Ideas:
  - Get Inspired – Display with Censored Books
  - Banned Books in Locked Crates
  - Fire Displays – Red Glitter Pages
- Suggestions for Banned Books Week:
  - Themes of truth tellers and previously oppressed
    - i.e., Fahrenheit 451 – books about censorship
  - Include a plaque in front of the book that includes why the book is banned
  - Focus on specific areas: Banned books in schools, reasons why books were banned, and pulling some pages from banned books.

- Banning History Does Not Make It Not True
- Book Clubs
  - Pairing an author or a topic that's been banned with a heritage month.
- Décor Themes – art display contest on portraying banned books, getting the public involved in the art displays
- Actionable ways for Library Commissioners to get the word out:
  - Social media
    - If everyone shared their favorite banned books and have the Library Commissioners highlighted on HPL's social media.
    - Highlight Favorite Banned Books of Pinnacle People of COH i.e., The Mayor, Fire Chief etc.
    - Friends of the Hayward Library are also interested in participating in Banned Books week
  - Nuance of Banned Books is dependent on an agency/establishment
  - The Banned Books list is Community driven
    - ALA List
  - Motioned by Commissioner Navarro to add Banned Books Week to the next Commission Agenda: seconded by Commissioner De Miguel. Passed 6-0-0.
