 - Fire Displays Red Glitter Pages
 - Suggestions for Banned Books Week:
 - Themes of truth tellers and previously oppressed
 - i.e., Fahrenheit 451 books about censorship
 - Include a plaque in front of the book that includes why the book is banned
 - Focus on specific areas: Banned books in schools, reasons why books were banned, and pulling some pages from banned books.
