RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH ADVOCATES FOR HUMAN POTENTIAL INC. TO ACCEPT \$389,260 IN GRANT FUNDING FOR THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH JUSTICE INTERVENTION SERVICES PROJECT AND APPROPRIATE THE FUNDING TO THE FEDERAL GRANTS SPECIAL REVENUE FUND

WHEREAS, the City of Hayward is committed to providing appropriate responses to community members experiencing mental illness, substance use and homelessness; and

WHEREAS, the Hayward Evaluation and Response Teams (HEART) program has been developed to more efficiently connect people who request emergency services to needed medical, mental health and other social services; and

WHEREAS, executing an agreement with Advocates for Human Potential, Inc. will provide funding to develop infrastructure and build the capacity of the HEART program to serve the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward that the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept funding from the California Department of Health Care Services in the amount of \$389,260; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Hayward hereby amends Resolution 21-100, the budget resolution for the City of Hayward Operating Budget for FY 2022, and approve the appropriation of \$389,260 in the Federal Grant Special Revenue Fund; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is authorized and directed to negotiate and execute contracts, and any supporting documents, with Advocates for Human Potential, Inc. to carry out services for the California Department of Health Care Services, Behavioral Health Justice Intervention Services project.
