Sacramento - Measure Y

To create a funding source dedicated to children and youth services, including homeless and foster youth, shall a 5% business operations tax on gross receipts of marijuana cultivation and manufacturing businesses be imposed, generating revenues potentially in the millions of dollars annually, to be used for children and youth services in the City of Sacramento?

City of Davis - Measure "C"

Shall Ordinance 2469 be adopted to add Article 19.04.100 to the Davis Municipal Code to establish a business license tax on non-medical (recreational) marijuana businesses within the city of no more than 10% of annual gross receipts of the business, which is estimated to raise \$200,000 annually if recreational marijuana sales are legalized and the City amends zoning to authorize marijuana businesses within City limits, and which will continue until repealed by City Council or city voters?

Alturas - Measure G

Shall an ordinance be adopted to impose a Business Tax at rate of 10% of gross receipts on Marijuana Collectives and Cooperatives operating in the city of Alturas?
