RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AGREEMENT(S) WITH FLOCK SAFETY FOR AUTOMATED LICENSE PLATE READER CAMERAS FOR UP TO TEN (10) YEARS WITH TOTAL EXPENDITURES NOT TO EXCEED \$4,000,000 OVER THE TEN-YEAR PERIOD

WHEREAS, the City of Hayward currently contracts with Flock Safety for sixty-four Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) cameras, and intends to expand the network by approximately thirty additional cameras; and

WHEREAS, the ALPR expansion is a key component of the City's public safety strategy, supporting real-time vehicle alerts, investigative capacity, and regional law enforcement coordination; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hayward seeks to enter into agreement(s) with Flock Safety for the purchase of ALPR cameras for up to ten (10) years with a total expenditure amount not to exceed \$4,000,000 over the ten-year period; and

WHEREAS, any future request to further expand the ALPR program beyond the current scope shall require additional City Council approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute agreement(s) with Flock Safety for the purchase of ALPR cameras for up to ten (10) years with a total expenditure amount not to exceed \$4,000,000 over the ten-year period.
