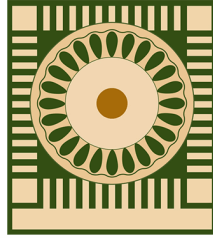

RECOMMENDATION

That the City Council: 1) reviews one Clean and Green Commission, two Community Services Commission, one Library Commission, and three Personnel Commission reappointment requests; 2) reviews the annual report of Council's appointed bodies including members' attendance records, completion of required trainings, and overall performance; and 3) confirms the process for conducting the annual City commission interviews on August 25, 2026.

SUMMARY

The annual recruitment for City commissions was conducted from March 10, 2026 through July 31, 2026. There are currently nine vacancies across the commissions, two members not seeking reappointment, and seven requests for reappointment, as summarized in Table 1. A total of sixty-nine applications were received by the submission deadline, and sixty-five applicants qualified for consideration. SUBJECT: City Commissions: Review of Seven Reappointment Requests and Approval of Interview Process for August 25, 2026

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The annual recruitment for City commissions was conducted from March 10, 2026 through July 31, 2026. There are currently nine vacancies across the commissions, two members not seeking reappointment, and seven requests for reappointment, as summarized in Table 1. A total of sixty-nine applications were received by the submission deadline, and sixty-five applicants qualified for consideration. Attachment II provides the final list of qualified applicants and their stated service preference. A digital binder containing all qualified applications was made available to the City Council on August 7, 2026.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact associated with this report.

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

City staff identified commission members with terms expiring in September 2026 and contacted them to confirm their interest in continuing to serve. Table 1 provides a summary of current vacancies and reappointment requests across all meeting bodies, and Tables 2 through 6 present detailed information for each individual body. Attachment III provides additional detail by meeting body including demographic data reflecting current membership composition. This information is intended to inform the City Council of existing representation and encourage consideration of candidates from sectors or groups that are not yet represented.

Interview Process for August 25, 2026

On August 7, 2026, staff provided Council Members with a digital binder containing a list of applicants, applicants' preferences by meeting body, completed applications, demographic information, and maps comparing the geographic distribution of current members and applicants. The materials were provided in advance to allow Council Members sufficient time to review the applications and complete the pre-screening process, which has been in place to identify candidates to be interviewed.

As part of the pre-screening process, each Council Member will complete the selection form (Attachment IV) and submit it by email to the City Clerk by Wednesday, August 19, 2026. Applicants who receive three or more points will be invited to interview with the City Council on August 25, 2026.

STRATEGIC ROADMAP

This agenda item is a routine operational item and does not relate to any of the projects outlined in the Council's Strategic Roadmap.

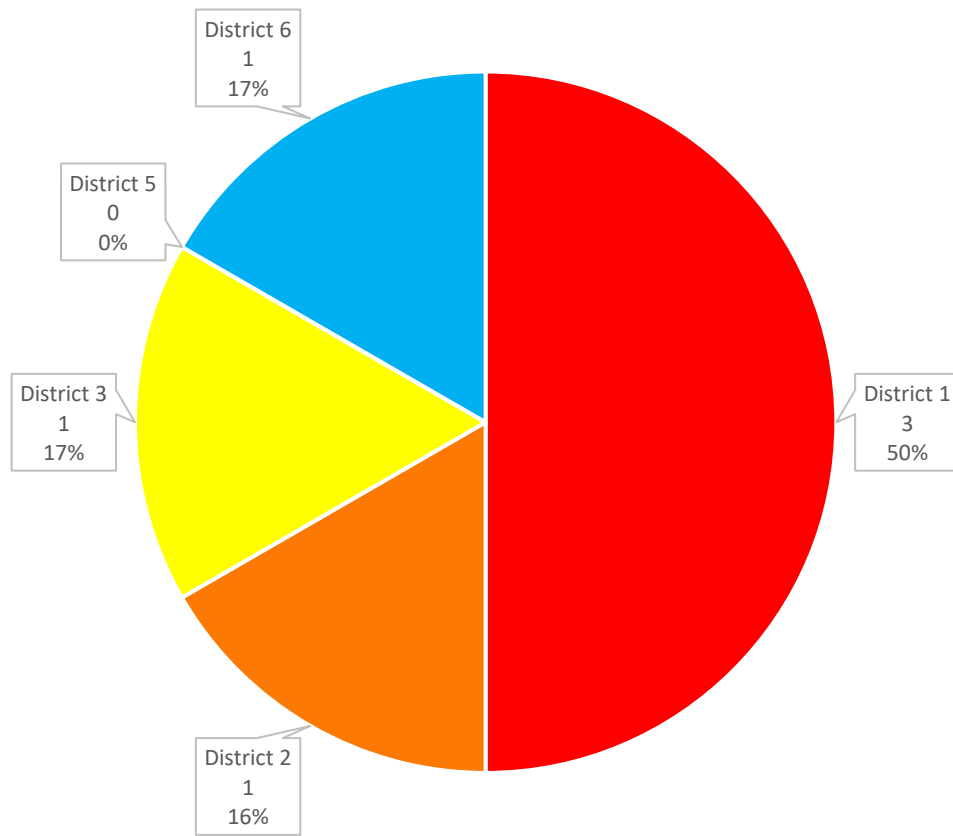


Adopted Neighborhoods
