SUBJECT: Adopt an Ordinance Amending Chapter 7, Article 2 (Streets) of the Hayward

Municipal Code Clarifying the Duty to Maintain and Repair Sidewalks; and Adopt a Resolution Appropriating \$30,000 from Fund 450 to Establish a Sidewalk

Repair Financial Hardship Program

RECOMMENDATION

That the Council adopts the Ordinance introduced on October 28, 2025 (Attachment II) and adopts a resolution (Attachment III) appropriating \$30,000 from fund 450 to establish a Sidewalk Repair Financial Hardship Program.

SUMMARY

This item entails the adoption of an Ordinance amending Chapter 7, Article 2 (Streets) of the Hayward Municipal Code clarifying the duty to maintain and repair sidewalks. The Ordinance was introduced on October 28, 2025, by Council Member Zermeño.

This item also appropriates \$30,000 from fund 450 to establish a hardship program to encourage and enable low-income property owners to repair damaged sidewalks, as described in the October 28, 2025, staff report.
