

PUBLIC NOTICE OF AN INTRODUCTION OF ORDINANCE
BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAYWARD

AN ORDINANCE ADDING ARTICLE 6 TO CHAPTER 11 OF THE HAYWARD
MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING RECYCLED WATER USE

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAYWARD DOES ORDAIN AS
FOLLOWS:

Upon adoption of this ordinance, Chapter 11, Article 6 of the Hayward Municipal Code
pertaining to policies regarding recycled water use is hereby enacted to read as follows:

SECTION 8.0: SEVERANCE. Should any part of this ordinance be declared by a final decision of a court or tribunal of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, invalid, or beyond the authority of the City, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance, which shall continue in full force and effect, provided that the remainder of the ordinance, absent the unexcised portion, can be reasonably interpreted to give effect to the intentions of the City Council.

SECTION 9.0: EFFECTIVE DATE. In accordance with the provisions of Section 620 of the City Charter, this ordinance shall become effective 30 days from and after the date of its adoption.

Introduced at the meeting of the Hayward City Council held December 1, 2015, the above-entitled Ordinance was introduced by Council Member Mendall.

This Ordinance will be considered for adoption at the regular meeting of the Hayward City Council, to be held on December 15, 2015, at 7:00 p.m., in the Council Chambers, 777 B Street, Hayward, California.
