RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVISE THE EAST BAY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION TO GRANT THE REMAINING COVID-19 RELIEF FUNDS TO SOUTH HAYWARD PARISH AND THEN TO CLOSE THE FUND

WHEREAS, the City of Hayward signed a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with East Bay Community Foundation (EBCF) in April of 2020 to launch the Hayward Community Relief Fund (Fund) to receive and direct charitable donations to sustain and protect Hayward residents and businesses during the COVID-19 health emergency; and

WHEREAS, there is a balance of \$135,795 remaining in the Fund; and

WHEREAS, as the longest standing food pantry in Hayward, South Hayward Parish is well positioned to continue to provide food access services, COVID-19 testing, and other basic needs for residents who have been hard hit over the past two years; and

WHEREAS, the Fund was established as a one-time fund for the specific purpose of providing relief services related to the COVID-19 pandemic and cannot be used for other purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to advise the EBCF to grant the remaining COVID-19 relief funds to South Hayward Parish and to then close the Fund.
