RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE \$162,360 IN AWARDED FEMA STATE HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM GRANT FUNDING FROM THE ALAMEDA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), through the State Homeland Security Program (SHSP), provides grant funding to enhance emergency preparedness and response capabilities; and

WHEREAS, the Alameda County Sheriff's Office, acting as the regional administrator of SHSP funds, has allocated \$162,360 to the City of Hayward for the expansion of its Automated License Plate Reader (ALPR) program; and

WHEREAS, the ALPR expansion will enhance terrorism response, improve real-time alerts for flagged vehicles, and strengthen overall public safety efforts within the City of Hayward.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward that the City Manager is hereby authorized to accept and appropriate \$162,360 in SHSP grant funding awarded by the Alameda County Sheriff's Office.
