2. Retail Corridor Tour: Tennyson Road (Oral Report Only)

The driving tour included visits to several key shopping centers and local businesses:

• **Mission Plaza:** The Committee met with **Jose Huitron** from *El Pastorcito* and **Jorge Flores** from *Don Polvoron* to discuss business operations and recent improvements supported through City programs including Hashtag Hayward and Resturant Relaunch

- **Tampa Square:** Members learned that both *DD's Discounts* and *Chavez Supermarket* are among the largest employers along the corridor.
- **Oliver's Corner:** The group discussed the status of the vacant *U.S. Bank* site and retail activity in the shopping center.
- **Tennyson Center:** It was noted that the Walgreens manager communicated to staff that this store remains fiscally stable and continues to serve as a key anchor business for the center.
- **Don Gaspachos:** The tour concluded with a visit to *Don Gaspachos*, where owner **Jose Martinez** shared updates on his recent Hashtag Hayward and the resulting improvements to his business' brand awareness and expanded customer base.
