RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE \$40,235.40 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE ALAMEDA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR THE FY 2022 BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT FOR HAYWARD POLICE DEPARTMENT OPERATIONS

WHEREAS, the Hayward Police Department has a long history of receiving Byrne Justice Assistance (JAG) Grant funds to support police department operations; and

WHEREAS, The County of Alameda applied for and was awarded a total allocation of \$693,444.00 in JAG funds, of which the Hayward Police Department will receive \$40,235.40; and

WHEREAS, these funds require no local match and will be used to support criminal justice and community policing related activities such as training, equipment, supplies, prevention and education programs, and other related law enforcement and corrections programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Hayward that the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to accept and appropriate the FY 2022 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant to the Byrne Grant Fund (Fund 820) in the amount of \$40,235.40.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Hayward hereby approve the amendment of the FY 2024 Operating Budget Resolution by increasing the approved budget appropriation in the Byrne Grant Fund (Fund 820) by \$40,235.40.
