Item # 2: Adoption of Ordinance Amending Chapter 10, Article 1 (Zoning Ordinance) and Article 24 (South Hayward Form Based Code) of the Hayward Municipal Code Rezoning Certain Property to Planned Development District in Connection with General Plan Amendment, Zone Change and Vesting Tentative Map Application No. 201704129 for the SoHay Mixed Use Development

Why aren't the rental units included in this provision? Are they not part of the HOA? Can they be added? That was certainly the intent of the motion, if possible.

The rental units are not part of the HOA. The HOA only covers the for sale properties. The motion was specifically related to the HOA paying a specific amount of transit passes and that is reflected in the condition. If the Council wants the rental units added, then they would need the applicant to agree for the property management company (a subsidiary of William Lyon or future owner of project) to agree to provide those passes annually to all households in the multi-family rental component.

If Council wants to modify the language in the Condition, staff has prepared a memo and amended Resolution to do so.

Item # 7: Resolution of Intention to Form the Downtown Hayward Community Benefit District.

Would you please share the proposed costs for Hayward's CBD in comparison with those from other jurisdictions? I realize the cost varies property to property, so an average cost or small set of sample costs would be helpful.

The attached document is from our consultant, which details the costs in comparison with other Bay Area and Southern California CBDs.

Item # 9: Status Update of the Fiscal Year (FY) 2018 Approved Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Biennial Fund Projects and Review of the FY 2019 Proposed Projects and Authorization to Reallocate \$1.9 Million of Unspent CDBG funds to Eligible Projects in FY 2019.

Can we use CDBG ED funds for demolition of the Caltrans homes? That is certainly an expense that will occur before May 2019.

Yes. Demolition of abandoned and deteriorated structures is an eligible CDBG expense and meets the HUD National Objective of Clearance - Spot Blight (24 CFR 570.201(d)). Staff has confirmed abatement and demolition will be completed in 2018.

However, the staff report recommends the entire **\$1,900,000** of unspent CDBG funds be re-allocated as follows:

- **\$314k** from FY 2018 Biennial Funds to St. Rose Hospital Clinical Laboratory Renovation;
- Of the unspent CDBG Entitlement funds, the recommended re-allocation is as follows:
 - Match funds for Measure A1 Affordable Rental Housing **(\$800,000)**;
 - Housing Rehabilitation Loan Program contract with Hello Housing **(\$100,000)**; and
 - St. Rose Hospital contract for equipment related to the renovation of the Clinical Lab **(\$686,000)**

Therefore, there are no CDBG funds available to allocate towards the demolition unless Council chooses to change the staff recommendation for the \$1,900,000 of available funds.

RECOMMENDATION

Based on a Council question, staff has prepared a revised a condition of approval and amendments to the resolution if the Council wishes to modify this as it relates to the second reading of the Ordinance and accompanying Resolution of approval for the Sohay development project.

As drafted, Condition No. 58k refers to the “for sale” units while the intent of the Councilmember who made the motion was to provide \$400 Clipper Cards to all households within the development, including the multifamily rental units. To ensure that all households benefit from the ongoing transit subsidy, staff recommends that Condition 58k be modified as follows (new text is underlined):

The Homeowner’s Association shall provide a \$400 Clipper Card annually to each for sale household and the property owner of the multi-family rental development shall provide a \$400 Clipper Card annually to each multifamily rental household, unless the applicable household declines the benefit in writing.

If the Council accepts this modification, it will be reflected in the Resolution accompanying the Ordinance.

Clean air right use for VW cash

The Wolf administration has developed a sound program for using the state's share of the national settlement with Volkswagen for its pervasive cheating on diesel emission standards.

Federal regulators discovered several years ago that certain VW small-car diesel engines were programmed to perform differently during emissions testing than they did under actual driving conditions. The emissions those engines produced in testing were far lower than what they produced on the road.

VW acknowledged the cheating and agreed to a \$14.7 billion national settlement, \$2.7 billion of which was distributed to state governments.

Last week, Gov. Tom Wolf announced that Pennsylvania's \$118 million piece of the settlement would help produce cleaner air. The Driving PA Forward program's goal is to reduce nitrogen oxide emissions from diesel engines by 27,200 tons by speeding up the replacement of older diesel engines.

Competitive grants will be available for emission reduction projects, and dedicated grants will be available for electric and hydrogen vehicles, replacement of old and dirty heavy-duty trucks and buses, systems enabling ships in port in Philadelphia and Erie to use onshore electrical systems rather than diesel generators, replacement of diesel-powered industrial equipment such as forklifts with electric models, and to diminish the use of an array of other diesel-powered vehicles at airports and ports, and on rail lines and depots.

In some cases, the grants will support the use of newer, cleaner diesel technology. In other instances, grants will fund conversions from diesel to other forms of power that produce fewer emissions.

But in all cases, the projects will go to producing cleaner air, which is a perfect use of the money derived from VW producing dirty air.

-Now you do. They have told you its coming."

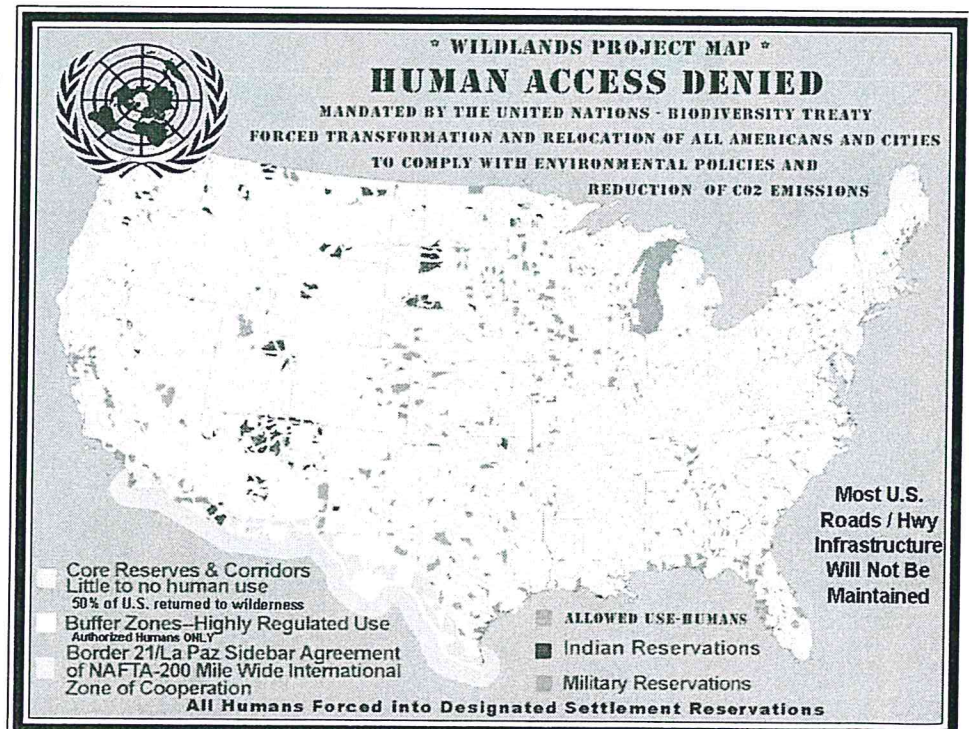
The goal of the **Wildlands Project** is to set aside approximately fifty (50) percent of the North American continent as "wild land" for the preservation of biological diversity.

- Cores, created from public lands such as National Forest and Parks
- Buffers, often created from private land adjoining the cores to provide additional protection

- The primary characteristics of core areas are that they are large (100,000 to 25 million acres), and allow for little, if any, human use.
- The primary characteristics of buffers are that they allow for limited human use so long as they are "managed with native biodiversity as a preeminent concern."
- Moral and ethical guidelines for the Wildlands Project are based on the philosophy of Deep Ecology.
- All life (human and non-human) has equal value.
- Resource consumption above what is needed to supply "vital" human needs is immoral.

Human population must be reduced

- Western civilization must radically change present economic, technological, and ideological structures.
- The Wildlands Project itself is supported by hundreds of groups working towards its long-term implementation. Implementation may take 100 years or more.
- The Wildlands Project has received millions of dollars in support from wealthy private and corporate foundations such as the Turner Foundation, Patagonia,

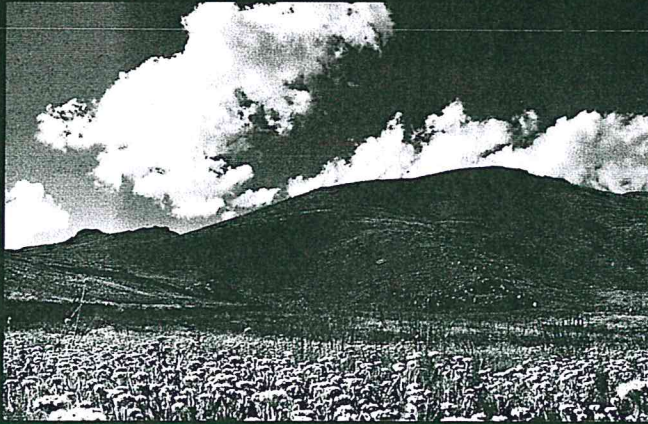

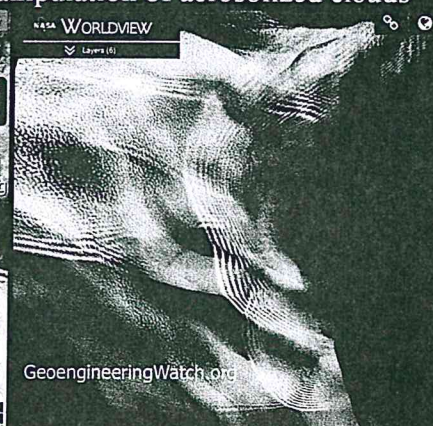
BEFORE: SKIES UNTAINTED BY CLIMATE ENGINEERING



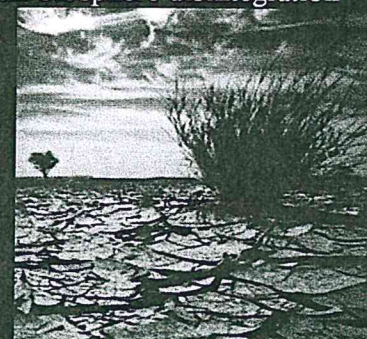
AFTER: SKIES CONTAMINATED BY SOLAR RADIATION MANAGEMENT

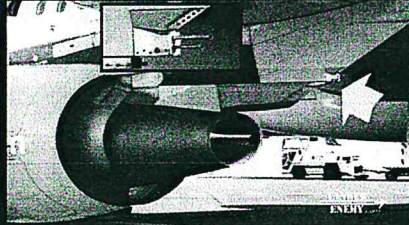

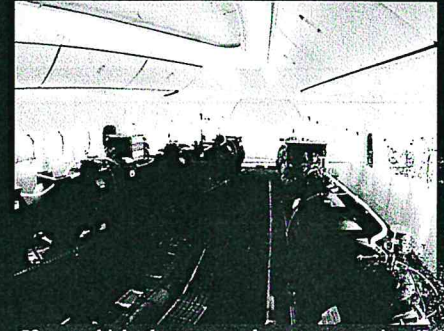

Massive plumes of climate engineering particulates are being dispersed by jet aircraft all over the globe, this is not condensation.

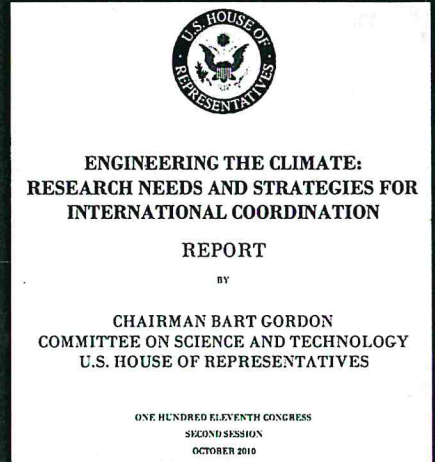
What are the known consequences of ongoing climate engineering operations?

GEOENGINEERING IS:

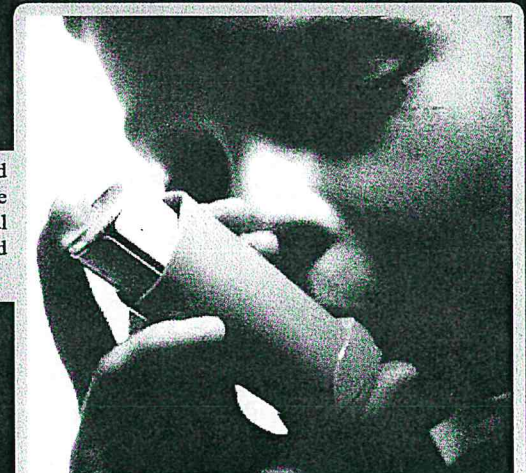
- **Further fueling the overall warming of our planet:**
