  allotted time (3 minutes).
- When joining by phone, click \*9 to raise a hand to speak. Press \*6 to unmute. We kindly request speakers to mute or turn down the meeting video when it is their opportunity to speak as it may cause interference with the speaker system.

# AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT 2021

\$65 Billion in Direct Federal Relief to cities

City of Hayward received approximately \$38 Million

\$2 Million allocated to Economic Recovery Efforts supporting local businesses and the workforce

Create permanent parklets for outdoor dining

Assist with costs for furniture, heaters, umbrellas, planters and more

Technical Assistance updating menus, on-line presence, marketing and loyalty programs

Approved Budget - \$250,000

A FAÇADE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM



- Allocate dollars for grants

  - Windows
- Combat blight and Activate Centers

Approved Budget - \$200,000




