 on an eligible agenda item. You will be permitted to speak during your turn and muted after the
 allotted time (3 minutes).
- When joining by phone, click *9 to raise a hand to speak. Press *6 to unmute. We kindly request speakers to mute or turn down the meeting video when it is their opportunity to speak as it may cause interference with the speaker system.
- Use headphones/mic for better sound quality and less background noise
- Decorum: Please be mindful that virtual meetings are public and will be recorded. All meeting rules






Revenue by Technology incubators was \$19.4 million compared to \$5.9 million for companies in mixed-use incubators



What's an Accelerator?


- Startup accelerators are fixed-term, cohort-based programs, that include mentorship and educational components and culminate in a public pitch event or demo day.
- As a specific type of accelerator, corporate accelerators are often subsidiaries or programs of larger corporations that act like seed accelerators.




Trend is more towards accelerators compared to incubators...

Running an accelerator in Hayward is viable...

- Needs to be industry/technology focused (corporate sponsor/integration)
- Requires significant overhead & management effort \$100k setup cost + \$350k, \$400k expenses yearly space for 20-30 individuals/founders



What's a coworking space?


Coworking spaces, or membership-based workspaces in which diverse groups of entrepreneurs and other nontraditional workers work together in a shared, communal space (Spreitzer et al., 2015:28).



Despite Covid-19 paradigm shift, there will be need for an "office space"...




Coworking industry is evolving into corporate sponsored co-working space model...




There's competition & Coworking space is getting crowded out

Top Players in the Coworking Space Market Share







GIFT HAYWARD A SHOP LOCAL GIFT CARD PROGRAM

- Assists businesses with setting up platform to accept gift cards and credit cards - Point of Sale Grant System
- •Rewards Patrons for supporting Hayward small businesses
- •Customers receive reward incentives to encourage gift card purchases
- •Similar programs offered in communities across the country and locally in Fremont, Livermore and Concord

Allocated Budget - \$250,000







POINT OF SALE GRANT PROGRAM


- Businesses eligible to receive up to \$800 towards the purchase of a new Point of Sale (POS) system
- Allows customers to use credit cards, including the Together for Hayward Gift Card
- 24 businesses approved to receive grants to date

PARTICIPATING BUSINESSES



OUTREACH EFFORTS TO SIGN-UP BUSINESSES

- •Bulk Email to all Retail, Food and Beverage, and Service uses that had email addresses registered with Business License.
- Personalized emails to all past grant recipients, concierge cases and others that have interacted directly with Economic Development
- Communication through The Stack newsletter and Chamber of Commerce newsletter
- Staff completed door-to-door visits in the downtown, Tennyson corridor, shopping centers in South Hayward, and Southland Mall.
- Intensive effort to personally visit businesses outside of downtown, along with production of multi-lingual materials, demonstrates commitment to equity and inclusion



Purchase any gift card \$20 - \$100 and receive a 50% bonus card!

Limit three per purchaser. Offer good while supplies last. Bonus card must be used within 90 days of purchase.

- Encourage customers to support one of the 40 restaurants during California
 Restaurant Month
- Between January 1 20, 2022 360 gift cards and bonus cards have been purchased/issued with a value of \$21,650



FISCAL IMPACTS

- Total Proposed Budget Gift Card Program \$250,000
- •\$166,000 remaining

- •Continue to promote the availability of the gift cards for purchase.
- Work with those businesses still interested in participating to get registered
- Provide grant dollars for those businesses that may need to purchase or upgrade their point-of-sale system
