## AGENDA QUESTIONS & ANSWERS MEETING DATE: SEPTEMBER 26, 2017

Item #9: Hayward Community Taskforce Recommended Update to the 1992 Anti-Discrimination Action Plan.

Q: Did the full Community Taskforce have an opportunity to review the recommendations of the Community / Police Relations (C/P) Sub-Committee, at a Taskforce meeting, prior to the recommendations being included in the DRAFT CIECC being presented this evening?

A: Due to exigent circumstances, the recommendations of the C/P Sub-Committee were <u>not</u> available for review and comment by the Community Taskforce at its last meeting on 8/14/17. There were several personally unavoidable circumstances that caused the delay in sharing the C/P recommendations with the full membership of the Taskforce.

These events occurred during the weeks leading up to the final Taskforce meeting. Consequently, the C/P Sub-Committee was unable to meet until 8/15/17, the day after the last meeting of the Community Taskforce. When the Sub-Committee met, it determined which of the many recommendations produced on this topic would be prioritized and included in the Community / Police Relations Two-Year Action Plan section of the CIECC.





















Top: The big picture in the creek
