Brown Act, Attendance Policy and Remote Meeting Structure - Miriam Lens, City Clerk & Michael Lawson, City Attorney

Why we meet in public? All government agencies are required to meet publicly because of the Brown Act. Refer to the Brown act because it is apart of our language and what is worked with everyday. Requires all legislative bodies, including the HYC, to be conducted in public. Agenda must be posted and the agenda will be followed thoroughly. City council is a legislative body and planning commission, personal commissions, library commission, community service commission, etc. are legislative bodies that are required to be met in public. All meetings have to be accessible to people with disabilities. Not allowed to have any secret meetings. Serial meetings are smaller groups meeting in public spaces, online, text, etc.

Need to meet Quorum in order for meeting to start. Needs to be a majority of 32. Meetings should allow for full discussion by all members, and members of the public are entitled to speak on issues.

Attendance Policy. Memebtrs are required to attend no less than 75% of all regular meetings held in one year. If a member is absent from three consecutive regualr meetings of the Commision without permission, the member's seat will be declared vacant by the City Council.
